

Getting Started ★ Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the USB cable into the USB charging port on the back of the speaker. Plug the other end into the USB port on your computer, a USB charging device, or a 5V USB charging adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn off when fully charged. On low power, a tone will be periodically heard, indicating that the speaker should be charged.

ON/OFF

Make sure that the speaker has been charged.

- Move the [Power] switch to the ON position. A tone will be heard and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The speaker will automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device
- Move the [**Power**] switch to the OFF position to power OFF.

☐ Playing Music

To listen to music on your speaker make sure it is paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device (see the **Bluetooth Pairing** section). Playback and volume adjustment is controlled with the paired or connected device.

- * Bluetooth Pairing

 1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the LED Bluetooth indicator will quickly flash BLUE.
- 2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select AR519 from the list of found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will slowly flash BLUE.
