



If using the AR530 as an alarm clock it is highly recommended that you plug it into a USB adapter and leave it plugged into an electrical outlet. The clock will remember its set clock and alarm times so long as it is powered or has battery remaining.

Location of Controls

(Front of Speaker)

- 1. [Snooze] Button: Snooze alarm 5 minutes
- 2. [Alarm] Button: Turn alarm ON/OFF
- 3. [Digit] Button: Adjust hour and minute digits
- 4. [Set] Button: Set clock and alarm time
- 5. Bluetooth LED Indicator
- (Back of Speaker) 6. [Power] Switch
- 7. Micro-USB Charging Port
- 8. Charging LED Indicator



Getting Started

Charging the Speaker

Insert the small connector of the included micro-USB charging cable into the micro-USB charging port on the back of the speaker. Insert the large connector into the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The charging LED indicator will *turn RED* while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. On low power, a tone will be heard indicating that the speaker needs to be recharged.

The clock will remember its set clock and alarm times as long as it has battery remaining.

Powering ON/OFF

Note: When powered off, the clock will remember its set clock and alarm times as long as it has battery remaining. If the battery dies completely, you will need to re-set the clock and alarm after recharging the speaker.

• Move the [Power] switch to the middle or ON position to power the speaker on.

• Move the [Power] switch to the ON position to power

the speaker and lights on. **OFF** · Move the [Power] switch

to the OFF position to power the speaker and lights off.

Plaving Music

To play music on the speaker, you must be paired to a Bluetoothenabled device. Once paired, playback and volume adjustment can be controlled via your media-playing device.

Using the Lights

- Move the [Power] switch to the ON position to power the speaker lights ON.
- Play music off of your device via Bluetooth®, and the lights will react to the music you play.
- •The lights will power OFF when the speaker is powered off.

Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will quickly flash BLUE.
- 2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select AR530 from the list of found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will slowly flash BLUE.

Note: Bluetooth pairing will turn off if not paired to a device within 5 minutes. If this happens, power the clock off and on

Setting the Clock & Alarm

- 1. Long press the [Set] button. The hour of the clock time will start blinking. Press the [Digit] button to increase the hour from 1-12. The clock display will show AM or PM.
- 2. Once you have selected the correct hour, press the [Set] button. The minute of the **clock time** will start blinking.
- 3. Repeat the above step to set the time minute, and alarm hour and minute.



Using the Alarm

Press the [Alarm] button to enable or disable the alarm. The alarm icon on the clock display will light up to indicate that the alarm is activated.

When the alarm is ringing:

- Press the [Snooze] button to snooze the alarm for 5 minutes. The alarm icon will blink.
- To completely disable the alarm, press the [Alarm] button. The alarm icon on the display will turn off to indicate that the alarm is disabled.
