🔊 Adjusting Volume and Playback

- Adjust volume by pressing and holding the [⏮/-] and [▶/+] buttons on the speaker, pressing the [⏮] and [▶] buttons on the remote control, or using a connected device. A tone will be heard when you have reached the speaker's min. or max. volume limit.
- Mute and unmute the volume by pressing the [⏸] button.
- Skip tracks or stations in Bluetooth mode and FM Radio mode by pressing the [⏮/-] and [▶/+] buttons on the speaker or the [⏮] and [▶] buttons on the remote control. Skip tracks in AUX mode using the controls on your device.
- Press the [▶||] button on the speaker or the [▶||] button on the remote control to pause and resume playback in Bluetooth mode. Use the controls on your device to pause and resume playback in AUX mode.

🔧 Using the Remote Control

The speaker must be switched ON in order to use the remote control.

- [⏻] Button: Enter or leave standby mode
- [MODE] Button: Switch between modes
- [▶||] Button: Pause and resume playback, Search FM stations
- [⏮] / [▶] Buttons: (Bluetooth) Skip tracks (FM Radio) Skip stations
- [⏸] Button: Mute/unmute volume
- [VOL+] / [VOL-] Buttons: Adjust volume

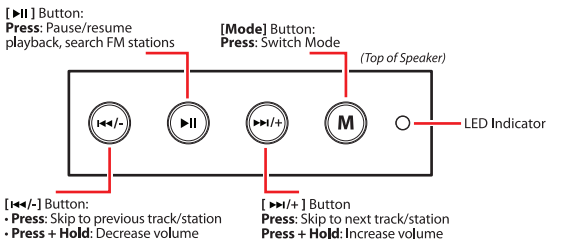

Getting Started

📦 Installing the Base

- Remove the speaker and contents from its packaging.
- Carefully turn the speaker upside down and place the wooden base on the underside, aligning the screw holes on the base with the screw holes on the speaker.
- Screw the base to the speaker with the supplied base screws.

When properly installed, the non-slip feet on the underside of the wood base should be touching the floor.

⚠ CAUTION

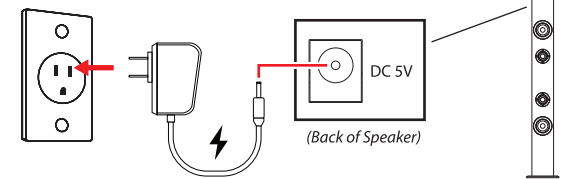
The speaker should be placed **ONLY** on a level, sturdy floor. Do NOT place on a table or other piece of furniture.

If using the FM radio, it is recommended that the speaker is placed near a window or area with an open view of the sky for best antenna reception.

For more on using the FM radio, please read the **FM Radio** section of this instruction manual.

⚡ Powering the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the included power adapter into the DC 5V Power Port on the back of the speaker. Plug the other end into an electrical outlet.



🔌 Powering ON/OFF

- Move the **[Power]** switch to the ON position. A tone will be heard, and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The speaker will automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device.
- Move the **[Power]** switch to the OFF position to power OFF.
- While the speaker is powered ON, you can enter and leave standby mode by pressing the [⏻] button on the remote control.

🎵 Playing Music

To listen to music on the speaker, you must be paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device (see the **Bluetooth Pairing** section) or connected with a 3.5 mm cable (see the **Using with a Wired Device** section).

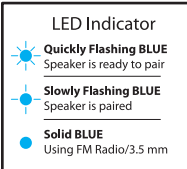
- Press the [M] button on the speaker or [MODE] button on the remote control to change between Bluetooth, FM radio, and auxiliary input modes. A 3.5 mm aux cable (*not included*) must be plugged in to switch to AUX mode.

Note: When inserting the 3.5 mm auxiliary cable into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack, the speaker will automatically switch to auxiliary mode.

🔗 Bluetooth Pairing

- Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard, and the LED indicator will **quickly flash BLUE**.
- Set your device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **AR1006** from the list of found devices.
- After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will **slowly flash BLUE**.

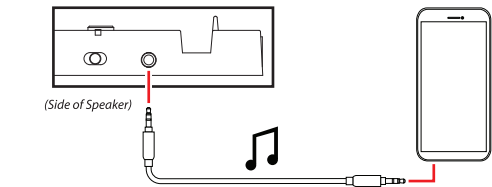
In Bluetooth mode, playback and volume adjustment can be controlled with the buttons on the speaker, the buttons on the remote control, or the controls on your paired device.



🔌 Using with a Wired Device

Plug one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary input cable (*not included*) into the 3.5 mm input port on the side of the speaker. Plug the other connector into your device. The speaker will automatically switch to aux mode, and the LED indicator will **turn solid BLUE**.

In aux mode, playback will be controlled by your paired device, and volume can be controlled with the buttons on the speaker, the remote control, or your paired device.



📻 Using the FM Radio

Switch input modes until you hear sound. The LED indicator will **turn solid BLUE**. This is FM Radio mode.

Press the [▶||] button on the speaker or remote control to scan stations. While scanning, the LED indicator will **quickly flash BLUE**. Press the [▶||] button again to stop scanning.

Press the [⏮/-] and [▶/+] buttons on the speaker or the [⏮] and [▶] buttons on the remote control to skip through scanned stations.

NOTE: The FM radio will have best reception where there is a clear line of sight to the sky.
