Attach the large connector to the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.</p> <p>The charging LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn off when fully charged. When low on power, a tone will be heard, indicating that the speaker should be charged.</p> <p>Power ON/OFF</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Slide the [Power] switch to the ON position to power the speaker and lights ON.• When powered ON, the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and will automatically reconnect to a previously-paired device in range with Bluetooth enabled.• Slide the [Power] switch to the OFF position to power the speaker and lights OFF. <p>Playing Music To listen to music on your speaker, make sure it is paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device. For more on pairing the speaker to your device, please consult the Bluetooth Pairing section on the next page.</p>	<h3>Bluetooth Pairing</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard, the lights will turn on, and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode.2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select AR1025 from the list of found devices.3. Once successfully paired, a tone will be heard and you will be able to play music on the speaker. <p>Pair to Bluetooth to listen wire-free!</p> <p>Once paired, you can control media playback and volume adjustment on your paired device.</p> <p>Using the Lights The lights will automatically power ON when the speaker is powered on. When playing music, the lights will react to the beat of your music. For best results, turn the volume up.</p>
