### Using the FM Radio

Change input modes until you enter FM radio mode.

In FM radio mode, playback will be controlled by the buttons on the speaker.

- Press the [ M ] button to start or stop automatically scanning and saving nearby FM radio stations. If not stopped, the radio to make a complete scan and save of all available radio stations, and return to the first saved station.

  Press the [ M ] and [ M ] buttons to skip through saved stations.

### Using a TF Card or USB Device

To insert a TF card, insert a TF card into the TF card slot on the speaker with the metal contacts facing down, and push in until it clicks.


