## USB Device and TF Card Input

Insert a USB device, such as a USB flash drive, or micro SD/TF card into the USB or TF card input ports on the speaker.

**Note:** To listen to music on your USB device, you may need to have files stored in the root folder of the device. Check your USB device's manufacturer information for more details.

If the speaker does not automatically switch to the correct mode, press the **[M/▶]** button until you enter USB or TF card mode. A voice will be heard indicating the mode, and the speaker will automatically begin playing music off the device.

In USB and TF mode, playback and volume adjustment will be controlled with controls on the speaker.

## Using a Microphone

Plug the 1/4" connector of a microphone (*not included*) into the microphone input port on the speaker. Switch the mic ON. It can be used in any mode.

- Press + hold the **[MIC VOL+/▶▶]** and **[MIC VOL-/◀◀]** buttons to adjust microphone volume.
- Adjust overall volume of audio and microphone input with the **[POWER/VOL]** dial on the speaker.

**Note:** In order to avoid loud feedback, keep the microphone behind the speaker and pointed away from the speaker, and switch the microphone off when not in use.

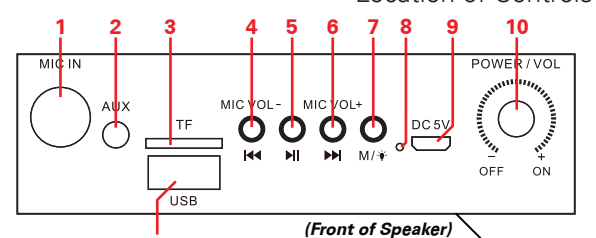

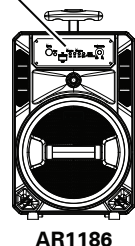

2. 3.5 mm AUX Port
3. TF Card Slot

Press: Skip to previous track  
Press+hold: Decrease mic vol.

## Getting Started

### Charging the Speaker

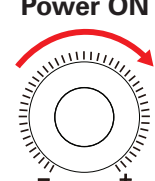
Plug the small connector of the included micro-USB charging cable into the DC 5V charging port on the speaker. Plug the large connector into a USB power source such as the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V USB adapter** (*not included*) and plug into a wall outlet.

The charging LED indicator will **turn RED** while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. On low battery, a tone will be heard indicating that the speaker needs to be recharged.

### Powering ON/OFF

- Turn the **[POWER/VOL]** dial **clockwise** until it clicks to power the speaker ON.
- When powered ON, a tone and a voice will be heard, and the speaker's LED lights will turn on. The speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and may automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired devices with Bluetooth enabled.
- Turn the **[POWER/VOL]** dial **counter-clockwise** until it clicks to power the speaker OFF.

### Power ON



### Changing Input Modes

Press the **[M/▶]** button on the speaker to switch between input modes. A voice will be heard indicating the mode.

You must have a TF card or USB device inserted to switch to these modes.

### Adjusting Volume & Playback

- Adjust volume with the **[POWER/VOL]** dial on the speaker in any mode, or the controls on a connected device.
- Press the **[MIC VOL+/▶▶]** and **[MIC VOL-/◀◀]** buttons on the speaker to skip tracks or stations in Bluetooth mode, FM Radio mode, USB mode and TF card mode.
- Press the **[▶||]** button to pause and resume playback in all modes except FM radio mode.

### Using the Speaker Lights

- The LED lights will automatically power ON when the speaker is powered on.
- Press + hold the **[M/▶]** button on the speaker to turn the LED lights ON and OFF while using the speaker.

### Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard, and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
2. Go to your device's Bluetooth Settings and search for new Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **AR1186** from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and you will be able to play music on the speaker.

In Bluetooth mode, volume & playback can be adjusted using the controls on your paired device, or the controls on the speaker listed in the **Adjusting Volume & Playback** section above.

### Using the FM Radio

Power the speaker ON and switch to FM mode. A voice will be heard indicating that the speaker is in FM radio mode.

All radio functions can be controlled with the buttons on the speaker.

- Press the **[▶||]** button to start or stop automatically scanning and saving nearby available radio stations. The speaker will automatically return to the first station when finished scanning.
- Press the **[MIC VOL+/▶▶]** and **[MIC VOL-/◀◀]** buttons to flip through saved stations.

### Using the AUX Input

Insert one end of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (*not included*) into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack on the speaker. Insert the other end into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm aux output port on your media-playing device.

Switch to AUX mode. A voice will be heard indicating the mode.

In AUX mode, media playback will be controlled by your connected device. Volume can be adjusted with the **[POWER/VOL]** dial on the speaker or with your connected device.
