





## Getting Started

Power ON

#### Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the included micro-USB charging cable into the DC 5V charging port on the speaker. Plug the large connector into a USB power source such as the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and

The charging LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. On low battery, a tone will be heard indicating that the speaker needs to

#### Powering ON/OFF

- Turn the [POWER/VOL] dial clockwise until it clicks to
- power the speaker ON.

   When powered ON, a tone and a voice will be heard, and the speaker's LED lights will turn on. The speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and may automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired
- Turn the [POWER/VOL] dial counter-clockwise until it clicks to power the speaker OFF.

#### Changing Input Modes

Press the [M/ \*] button on the speaker to switch between input modes. A voice will be heard indicating the mode.

You must have a TF card or USB device inserted to switch to these modes.

## Adjusting Volume & Playback

#### Using the AUX Input

Insert one end of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (not included) into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack on the speaker. Insert the other end into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm aux output port on your media-playing device.

Switch to AUX mode. A voice will be heard indicating the mode.

In ALIX mode, media playback will be controlled by your connected device. Volume can be adjusted with the **[POWER/VOL]** dial on the speaker or with your connected device.
