

## Getting Started

## Charging the Speaker

Insert the small connector of the included USB charging cable into the charging port on the back of the speaker. Insert the large connector into a USB power port or into a 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into an electrical outlet.

The LED indicator on the back of the speaker will turn RED while charging and



- Press the [Power] button on the front of the speaker to power the speaker & LED lights ON and OFF.
