

Wall Mounting the Soundbar

- Remove the speaker and its contents from packaging.
 Using a pencil, mark two spots on a wall measuring 33.8 inches apart.

- If installing to a wooden surface, drive or drill a mounting screw into the wall at each marked location. If installing to drywall or a brick surface, you may need to install plastic anchors to properly secure the mounting screws

Powering ON/OFF
