Setting Up

Pull the top of the spring-loaded device holder up, and insert your device. The holder should grip the device securely.

Plug the selfie stick's attached 3.5 mm connector into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm audio port on your device. Some devices may require an adapter or dongle to work with the selfie stick. Consult your device's instruction manual for information.

Using the Selfie Stick & Mic

Install your device. On your device, open the karaoke, video or photo app you would like to use. The selfie stick & mic is compatible with most video recording photography apps.

- In photography mode, press the button on the side of the microphone to take a picture.
- In video mode, press the button on the side of the microphone to start or stop recording. The microphone will record your audio.

Using the Headphone Jack

You can listen to your device's audio through the headphone jack on the side of the microphone.

To use this feature, plug the 3.5 mm connector of your headphones (not included) into the 3.5 mm audio port on the side of the microphone.
