

<p>TF Card Input Insert a micro SD/TF card into the TF card input port on the headphones.</p> <p>Change input modes until you enter TF card mode. The headphones will automatically begin playing music off the device.</p> <p>In TF card mode, control playback with the controls on the speaker.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press the [⏪/⏩] button to pause and resume playback.Press + hold the [⏮/⏭] and [⏮/⏭] buttons to skip tracks. <p>Using the FM Radio Change input modes until you enter FM radio mode.</p> <p>In FM radio mode, playback will be controlled by the buttons on the headphones.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press the [⏪/⏩] button to start or stop scanning and saving available radio stations. If it is not stopped, the radio will make a complete scan and save of all nearby radio stations.Press+ hold the [⏮/⏭] and [⏮/⏭] buttons to skip through saved stations. <p>Phone Calls When connected to a phone via Bluetooth, phone functions can be used on the headphones.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press the [📞] button to answer an incoming call. Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer, or a 5V USB wall adapter (not included).</p> <p>When the headphones are low on power, a tone will be heard indicating that it needs to be recharged.</p> <p>Powering ON/OFF</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press + hold the [⏪/⏩] button for 2 seconds to power ON. A tone will be heard, and the headphones will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. They will automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device with Bluetooth enabled.Press + hold the [⏪/⏩] button for 3 seconds to power OFF. <p>Adjusting Volume</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press the [⏮/⏭] and [⏮/⏭] buttons to adjust volume. <p>Using the LED Lights</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">The built-in LED lights will automatically turn on when the headphones are powered ON/OFF.Press + hold the [📞] button to turn the LED lights ON/OFF while the headphones are powered on. <p>Changing EQ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press the [M/EQ] button to change between EQ modes (normal, pop, rock, jazz, country, heavy bass).	<p>Changing Input Modes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press + hold the [M/EQ] button to switch input modes.You must have an AUX cable connected or TF/micro SD card inserted to switch to AUX or TF input mode. <p>Bluetooth Pairing</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Power the headphones ON. A tone will be heard, the LED indicator will flash RED and BLUE, and the headphones will enter Bluetooth pairing mode.Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select ASA106 from the list of found devices.After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard, the LED indicator will turn solid BLUE, and you will be able to play music on the headphones. <p>In Bluetooth mode, playback and volume can be adjusted by the controls on the front of the speaker, or by the controls on your paired device.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Press the [⏪/⏩] button to pause and resume playback.Press + hold the [⏮/⏭] and [⏮/⏭] buttons to skip tracks. <p>Using the 3.5 mm AUX Input Insert one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (not included) into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input port on the headphones.</p> <p>Insert the other connector into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm aux output port on your media-playing device.
