

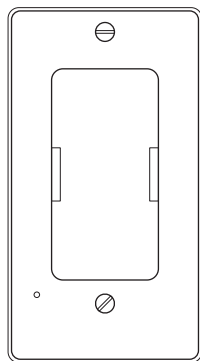

ONCE POWER HAS BEEN DISCONNECTED, test the outlet using a voltage meter capable of making the proper readings PRIOR to the installation of the item to ensure that the power has been properly disconnected.

If you are unsure or confused about anything presented in this manual involving disconnecting the power to a circuit, **please consult a QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN.**

Installation

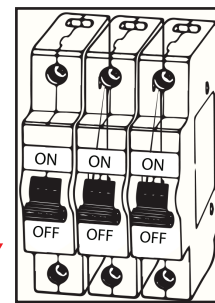
1. Turn Off the Power

Locate the electrical cutoff point (fuse box, breaker panel, etc.) and turn off the power to the outlet being used by turning off the breaker switch or removing the fuse, as necessary.

NOTE: If you are unsure what this is or where it is located, please consult a qualified electrician.

After the outlet is powered OFF, test it using a voltage meter or by plugging a device into the outlet, such as a light, and turning it ON.

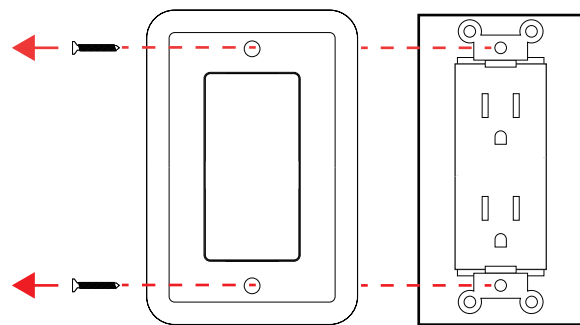
Once you have confirmed that the power to the outlet is OFF, you may proceed to step 2.



2. Remove the Existing Outlet Cover

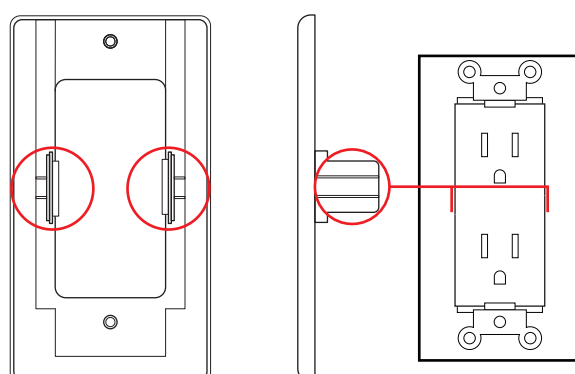
NOTE: This section will require the use of a screw driver.

Unscrew and remove the existing cover from the wall to reveal the outlet.



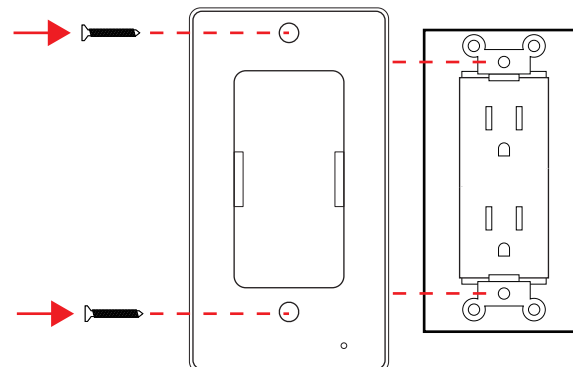
3. Install the Outlet Cover

Slide the outlet cover into the outlet so that **the two prongs clip into place** on both sides of the middle of the outlet.



4. Finish Up

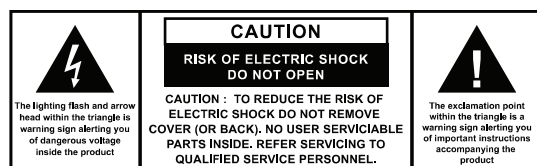
Screw both outlet cover screws into the outlet's top and bottom screw holes.



Return power to the outlet via breaker or circuit box and test to ensure it is functioning. The LED lights on the outlet cover will turn on automatically when the room is dark and turn off when the room is light.

Compliance Information



1. Follow all instructions.
2. Do not use this apparatus near water.
3. Clean only with a dry cloth.
4. Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
