General Warnings

Setting Up

- The disc comes with batteries already installed. Pull the tab marked "PULL" to remove the spacer insulating the batteries.
- Press the button on the battery compartment on the underside of the disc to turn the disc lights ON/OFF and cycle through the light modes:
 - 1. Alternate Flashing
 - 2. Strobe Flashing
 - 3. Solid Light

Replacing the Batteries

- Using a small screwdriver (not included), unscrew the battery compartment screw on the underside of the disc. Remove the screw and battery recover.
- Remove the old batteries, and dispose of according to local laws. Insert three (3) 1.5V LR44 alkaline manganese button batteries, following the polarity diagram in the battery compartment. Do not mix new and old batteries, or mix different brands or types of battery.
- Replace the battery cover. Replace the screw, and screw closed.
