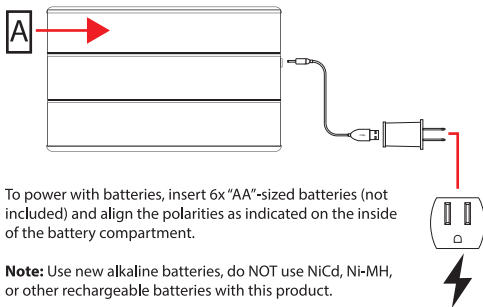

Setup

The light box can be powered via the supplied USB power cable or with six (6) AA-sized alkaline batteries.

To power with the USB cable, attach the pin to the power jack located on the side of the light box. Plug the USB connector into the USB port of your computer, USB charging device, or 5V USB adapter (*not included*) and plug into a wall outlet.

Getting Started



To power with batteries, insert 6x "AA"-sized batteries (not included) and align the polarities as indicated on the inside of the battery compartment.

Note: Use new alkaline batteries, do NOT use NiCd, Ni-MH, or other rechargeable batteries with this product.

Mounting the Light Box

Using a pencil, mark two spots on a wall 7.5" apart and drill holes at each spot. Insert the two plastic anchors into the wall, then, using the drill or a screwdriver (*neither included*), drive the mounting screws into the plastic anchors and hang the light box.

Using the Light Box

The light box has 100 letters- and character- slides that can be inserted into the slots.

Once setup, press the [**Power**] button on the side of the light box to turn ON/OFF.
