

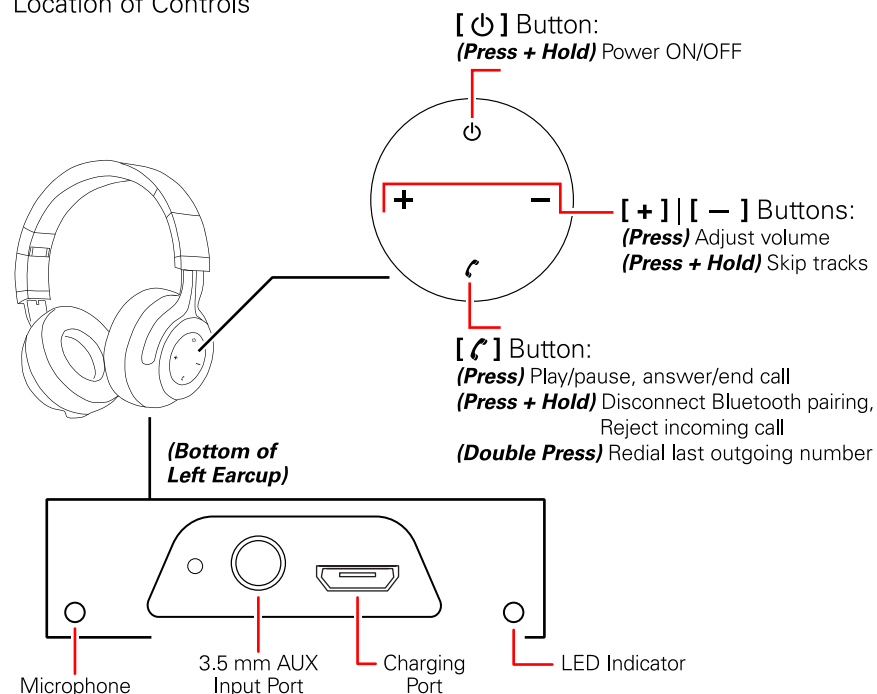

Location of Controls

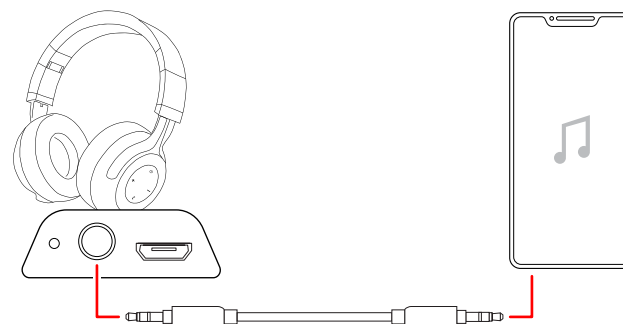


Using the AUX Input

Plug one connector of the included 3.5 mm AUX cable into the 3.5 mm AUX input port on the bottom of the left earcup. If the headphones are powered on when the AUX cable is plugged in, a tone will be heard and they will automatically power OFF. The headphone LED indicator will turn OFF when the headphones are in AUX mode.




Plug the other connector into the headphone jack or audio output port of your media-playing device. Certain devices may need an adapter to work with the AUX cable (*not included*).

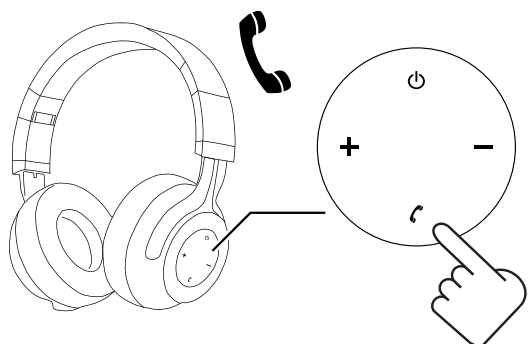
In AUX mode, all playback and volume adjustment will be controlled by your connected device.



Phone Calls

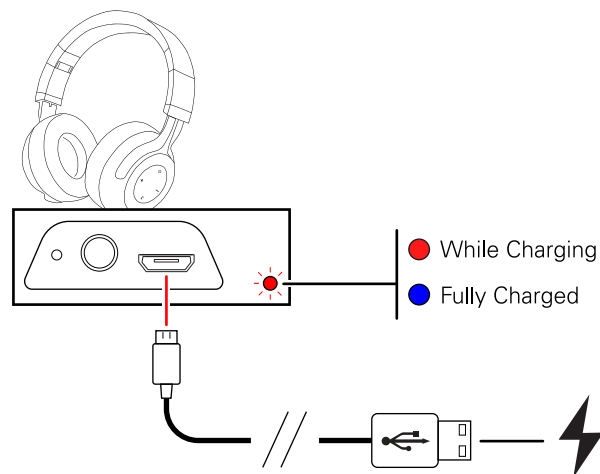
When paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device, you can use the device's phone functions with the headphone controls listed below.

- Press the [] button to answer/end an incoming phone call.
- Press and hold the [] button to reject an incoming phone call.
- Double press the [] button to redial the last outgoing phone number called.




Charging the Headphones

Insert the small connector of the supplied USB charging cable into the charging port on the bottom of the left earcup. Insert the large connector into the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a **5V/1A USB adapter** (not included) and plug into an electrical outlet.



The LED indicator will **turn RED** while charging and **turn BLUE** when fully charged. On low power a tone will be heard, indicating that the headphones should be recharged.

Powering On/Off

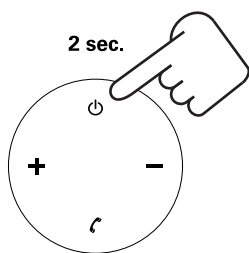
- Press and hold the [] button for 2 seconds to power the headphones ON or OFF. A voice will be heard indicating that the headphones have powered ON or OFF.
- When powered on, the headphones will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and will automatically re-pair to any nearby previously-paired device with Bluetooth enabled.

Note: The headphones will automatically shut off if not connected to a Bluetooth device within 5 minutes.

Listening to Music

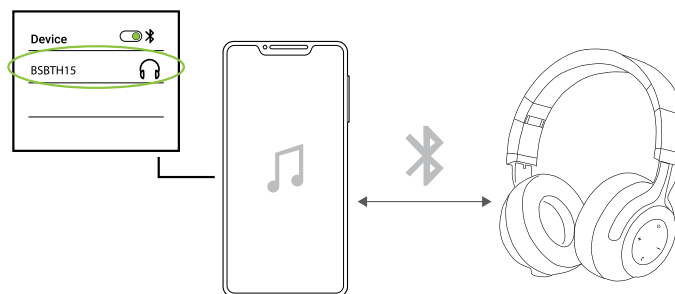
To listen to music on the headphones, they must be charged and properly connected to your Bluetooth-enabled device, or properly connected with the included 3.5 mm auxiliary cable. See the **Bluetooth Pairing** and **Using the AUX Input** sections of this manual for instruction.

In Bluetooth mode, playback can be adjusted using the controls on the headphones or your connected device. In AUX mode, all playback will be adjusted with your connected device.









Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the headphones ON. The LED indicator will **quickly flash RED and BLUE**.
2. Open your device's Bluetooth menu and select **BSBTH15** when it appears.
3. Another voice will be heard, indicating that the headphones are successfully connected to your device. The LED indicator on the headphones will **turn solid BLUE**.



In Bluetooth mode, you can control audio playback using your paired device, or with the controls on the headphones listed below.

- Press the [] button to pause/resume audio playback.
- Press and hold the [] and [] buttons to skip tracks.
- Press the [] and [] buttons to adjust volume.
- Press and hold the [] button for **1 second** to disconnect a Bluetooth pairing.
