

Connecting with a 3.5 mm AUX Cable

Plug one end of the included 3.5 mm auxiliary cable into the 3.5 mm AUX input port on the bottom of the earcup. Plug the other end into the audio output port on your media-playing device.


In auxiliary mode, all playback and volume adjustment will be controlled by your connected device.



Charging the Headphones

Plug the small connector of the included power cable into the charging port on the headphones' left earcup. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer or a compatible **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The headphones' LED indicator will **turn solid RED** while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. On low battery, a voice will be heard, indicating that the headphones need to be charged.



Powering ON/OFF

- Press and hold the [(1)] button for ~3 seconds to power the headphones ON or OFF.
- When powered on, a voice will be heard and the headphones will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. They may automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device with **Bluetooth** enabled.

To listen to music on the headphones, you must be paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device or connected via the 3.5 mm AUX port. **Consult the Bluetooth Pairing** or **Connecting with a 3.5 mm AUX Cable** sections of this manual for further instruction.

Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Power the headphones ON. A voice will be heard, and the LED indicator will **flash BLUE** and **RED**
- Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. Select BSBTH254 from the list of found devices.
- After a successful pairing, a voice will be heard and the LED indicator will turn solid BLUE.

In Bluetooth mode, playback and volume can be adjusted with the on-ear controls, or with your paired device.

- Press the [▶II] button to pause and resume playback.
- Press the [+] and [-] buttons to adjust volume.
- \bullet Press and hold the [+] and [] buttons to skip tracks.

Phone Calls

To use the phone functions on the headphones, you must be connected to a Bluetooth-enabled device.

- Press the [▶II] button to answer and end phone calls. Playback will automatically pause and resume
- Press and hold the [▶II] button to reject an incoming call.
