- Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will quickly flash BLUE.

Using the AUX Port

Plug one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (not included) into the AUX port on the speaker. Plug the other connector into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm audio output on your device. If the speakers are paired to each other, the AUX connection may only work with one of them

Storage & Maintenance

TWS Pairing

The speakers can be used independently, or wirelessly paired to each other using the following instructions.

- 1. *Press + hold* both speakers' [**Power**] buttons at the same time **for 2-3 seconds**. A tone will be heard from both speakers and their LED indicators will flash BLUE
- After about 10 seconds, the speakers will automatically pair to each other, and a tone will be heard. One speaker's LED indicator will flash BLUE, and the other's will turn solid BLUE

If the speakers do not pair to each other, press one of the speakers' [**Power**] buttons 2x quickly. The speakers should then automatically pair to each other within 5-10 seconds.

• 2x press the [Power] button on either speaker to disconnect/reconnect the TWS pairing.

Powering ON/OFF

- Press and hold the **[Power]** button to power the speaker ON and OFF. The **[Power]** button can be pressed through the protective rubber seal.



Using in Wet Conditions

This speakers have an Ingress Protection rating of **IPX5**. This means that they are protected against jets of water, with limited ingress permitted. They are NOT protected from submersion in water, such as flooding.

Always make sure that the protective rubber seal is completely covering the control panel before using the speaker in wet conditions. **Never charge the speaker or use the AUX port in wet conditions.**

Charging the Speakers

Undo the protective rubber seal on the side of the speaker and plug the small connector of the supplied charging cable into the micro-USB charging port. Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer or a 5V/1A USB wall adapter (not included).

The LED indicators will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. On low power, a tone will be heard indicating that the speaker needs to be charged.
