

Using the FM Radio

For best reception, untie and extend the antenna wire on the back of the clock and position it towards an open space where it will have direct line of sight with the sky, such as a window.

- 1. Tap the M button to enable/disable the FM radio.
- 2. Press and hold the (M) button to scan and save nearby radio stations.
- 3. Use the \oplus and \bigcirc buttons to skip through saved radio stations.

Radio volume can be adjusted by pressing the button. While adjusting, the current level will be shown on the clock display (between 00-15).

Sunset Time

A sunset time can be set for the alarm clock. 30 minutes before the set time, the light will reduce from 100% intensity until it turns off.

Tap the 😂 button to enable/disable the sunset time. When enabled the 🖄 symbol will appear on the clock display.

Press and hold the ⊗ button, the hour on the clock display will begin flashing. Use the ⊕ and ⊝ buttons to adjust the hour. Tap the ⊗ button to confirm.

Note: Setting will be cancelled if not confirmed within ~5 seconds.

2. After confirming the hour, the minute on the clock display will flash. Use the ⊕ and ⊝ buttons to adjust the minutes. Tap the ❷ button to confirm.

You can disable the light by pressing and holding the ⊕ button for ~3 seconds.


Using the Lamp

- Tap the ⊗ button to turn on the white light on the lowest intensity. Adjust the intensity level by pressing the ⊕ and ⊖ buttons.
- Press the ⊗ button a 2nd time to switch to color-changing mode. In this mode, the lamp will slowly fade through colors. Tap the ⊕ and ⊖ buttons to switch to a specific color.
- Press the

 button a 3rd time to disable the light.

Powering the Clock

The clock can be powered with the included USB power cable or 2 AAA alkaline batteries. If using batteries, insert according to the polarity diagram on the inside of the battery compartment. Do not mix old and new batteries or different brands or sizes of batteries.

Note: When powering the clock with batteries, all light functions will NOT work. The light will only work when the clock is powered via USB.

Plug the small connector of the supplied power cable into the USB power input on the back side of the clock. Plug the other connector into a USB power source, such as a **5V/1A USB adapter** (not included) and plug into an electrical outlet.

Once the clock is powered on it will automatically enter Time Setting mode.

Setting the Time

1. When powered on, the hour on the clock display will begin flashing. Use the \bigoplus and \bigoplus buttons to adjust the hour. Tap the s button to confirm.

Note: If no action is taken after 10 seconds the time will automatically set. **To restart Time Setting mode, press the** ③ **button**.

- 2. After confirming the hour, the minute on the clock display will flash. Use the \bigoplus and \bigoplus buttons to adjust the minutes. Tap the 6 button to confirm.
- 3. Tap the button on the back of the clock to select 12h or 24h time format. When the 12h format is selected, AM/PM will be displayed on the clock.

The brightness level of the clock display can be set with the ① button on the back of the clock.

- The clock will be on low brightness by default.
- Press the ① button once for high brightness.
- Press the (1) button a second time to turn the display off.
- If the display is off, press the ① button to turn it back on in low brightness.

Setting the Alarm

Tap the 🔘 button to enable/disable the alarm. When enabled the 🌢 symbol will appear on the display.

1. Press and hold the ⊚ button for ~3 seconds. The hour on the clock display will begin flashing. Use the ⊕ and ⊖ buttons to adjust the hour. Tap the ⊚ button to confirm.

Note: Setting will be cancelled if not confirmed within ~5 seconds.

- 2. After confirming the hour, the minute on the clock display will flash. Use the ⊕ and ⊖ buttons to adjust the minutes. Tap the ⊚ button to confirm.
- 3. The alarm will play nature sounds by default. Press the ② button then use the ⊕ and ⊝ buttons to select a different nature sound (1-6) or the FM radio (7)*. When switching to a new sound, a 5 second preview of the sound will play. Press the ③ button again to confirm the sound for the alarm.
 - *-for more on the FM radio, refer to the FM Radio section later in this instruction manual.

When the alarm goes off you can snooze the alarm for 5 minutes by tapping the button or disable it by tapping any other button on the front of the clock. The alarm will play its set sound for 2 minutes.

Sunrise Wake-Up

The sunrise wake-up will begin 30 minutes before the alarm goes off. It will increase light from 10% to 100%. During the sunrise wakeup, the symbol on the clock display will flash.

You can disable the light by pressing and holding the ⊗ button for ~3 seconds.
