

Setup

Plug the small connector of the supplied micro-USB power cable into the micro-USB port on the charging pad. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer, a USB power pack, or a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The LED indicator on the bottom of the charging pad will **flash BLUE** to indicate that the charging pad has power.



Using the Charging Pad

After plugging in the charging pad, place your device in the center of the pad. The LED indicator will *turn solid BLUE* to indicate that it is charging.

If your device does not begin to charge, try repositioning it on the charging pad. You may need to remove your smartphone case if you are using one. After your device is fully charged, disconnect and unplug the charging pad.
