# Before You Begin...

To ensure safe and proper use, read all safety information before using the device. Only use with manufacturer-approved batteries, chargers, accessories, and supplies.


- THIS DEVICE IS NOT A TOY, do NOT allow children or pets to use or play with this device.

### Installing the Batteries

Remove the battery cover from the bottom of the clock. Insert 3 new AAA-sized Alkaline batteries following the polarity (+/-) diagram in the compartment. Do not mix old and new batteries, or mix different types or brands of battery. Replace the battery cover.



# Getting Started

## Clock Display Modes


The clock display will automatically turn ON after batteries are installed. The clock will show the time by default.

- Press the [ADJ] button once to display the alarm time.
- Press the [ADJ] button a 2nd time to display the date (MMDD).
- Press the [ADJ] button a 3rd time to display the seconds.
- Press a 4th time to return to the time.

**Note**: the clock will automatically return to time display if no button is pressed after several seconds.

## Setting the Clock Time and Date

- Press the [SET] button 4 times. The current month (1-12) will be displayed. Press the [ADJ] button to increase the month to the desired digit, then press [SET] to save. The current day will now be displayed.
- Press the [ADJ] button to increase the day to the desired digit, then press [SET] to save.
- Repeat the above step to set the hour (AM/PM) and then minute of the current time. The clock will return to default time display.



# Setting the Alarm Time

- Press the [SET] button. The alarm clock time will blink, with "AL" appearing in the middle of the numbers. Press [SET] again. The hour of the alarm time will flash, along with "A" or "P" indicating AM or PM.
- Press the [ADJ] button to increase the alarm time hour to the desired digit, then press [SET] to save. The alarm time minute will now blink.
- Press the [ADJ] button to increase the alarm time minute to the desired digit, then press [SET] to save. The alarm time will be saved, and the clock will return to default time display.

**Note**: If you do not turn change any alarm settings, the clock will continue on to setting the date and current time.

### Turning the Alarm ON/OFF

Press the [SET] button. The alarm clock time will blink.

- Press [ADJ] once to turn the alarm ON. The [ (1- ] icon will appear at the top of the display, indicating that the alarm is on.
- Press **[ADJ]** a 2nd time to turn both the alarm and the hourly tone ON. The [ (+ ] and **[** .] icons will appear on the display.
- Press **[ADJ]** a 3rd time to turn the alarm OFF but keep the hourly tone ON. The **[** ] icon only will appear on the display.
- Press **[ADJ]** a 4th time to turn both the alarm and the hourly tone OFF. Neither icon will appear on the display.

If you have changed the previous settings, press **[SET]** 3 times to save and return to time display. Otherwise, press **[SET]** 7 times to return to time display.

# Shutting Off the Alarm

- When the alarm is ringing, press the **[ADJ]** button to snooze for 5 minutes. The **[** (1· **]** icon will flash at the top of the clock display while in snooze mode.
- Press the **[SET]** button to shut the alarm off until the next day. The [ (+ ] icon will appear solid on the display.
- To turn the alarm off completely, follow the instructions in the **Turning the Alarm ON/OFF** section above. The [ (+ ] icon will disappear when the alarm is turn off.


## Using the Projector

Move the power switch on the bottom of the clock to turn the star projector ON and OFF.

When powered ON, the projector lights will turn on and start cycling through different colors.

To project the clock display, press down on the top of the clock until it clicks. The clock will project the display in red light for ~15-20 seconds before fading away.

For best results, project onto a surface that is at least 2 feet away.
