

# Getting Started

## Charging the Speaker

- 1. Unzip the front compartment of the fanny pack, and pull the speaker out.
- Plug the small connector of the supplied micro-USB charging cable into the charging port on speaker. Plug the large connector into a USB power source such as the USB port on a computer, or into a 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.
- 3. The charging LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn off when fully charged. When fully charged, disconnect the charging cable, place the speaker back in its fanny pack compartment, and zip closed.

When low on power, a tone will be heard, indicating that the speaker should be recharged.

Powering ON/OFF

- Move the [Power] switch to power the speaker ON or OFF.
- When powered on, the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and may automatically re-pair to a nearby previously-paired device.

## Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will **quickly flash BLUE**.
- Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select CWPD720 from the list of found devices.
- Once successfully paired, a tone will be heard and the Bluetooth LED indicator will slowly flash BLUE.

Once paired, all playback and volume adjustment will be controlled by your paired device.
