



- 1. Unscrew the humidifier top from the humidifier base.
 2. Pour water into the humidifier base's water tank. Use only
- clean tap water or mineral water. Do not use essential oils, as they can block humidification or damage the humidifier.
- 3. For best results, wet the sponge wick completely for 2 minutes before attempting to use. Be careful not to lose the spring that fits under the sponge wick.

 4. Replace the humidifier top and screw into place.



Getting Started

- Using the Diffuser Set up the humidifier and connect to power.

 • Press the [Power] button to turn the humidifier ON in
- Press the [Power] button a 2nd time to switch the humidifier to Intermittent Mist mode. The humidifier will alternately mist for 3 seconds, and then turn off for 2 $\,$
- Press the [Power] button a 3rd time to turn the humidifier

 $\textbf{Note} \hbox{: } \textit{The humidifier will automatically power OFF after 8}$ hours. Turn on again to continue use.



Using the Night Light Press and hold the **[Power]** button for 2 seconds to turn the humidifier's built-in night light ON and OFF.

Cleaning and Maintenance

When you are finished using the humidifier, unplug and store the cable. Remove the humidifier from water, and allow the sponge wick to dry.

Replace the sponge wick every 3 months or when it changes color. Be careful not to lose the spring that fits under the sponge wick when replacing.
