

 - 3. Place a few drops of essential oil onto the rocks. 4. Replace the tray onto the bottom of the humidifier.




Setting Up the Humidifier

1. Pull up on the humidifier top to remove 2. Pour water into the humidifier base's water tank. Use only clean tap water or mineral water. Do not exceed the MAX level line. Do not put essential oils into the humidifier water tank, as they can block humidification or damage



Connecting to Power

A Warning: Do not allow the power cable, port or any power adapter (not included) to come into contact with water.

Plug the small connector of the included USB power cable into the power port on the humidifier top. Plug the large connector into a USB power port or into a compatible **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.



Using the Humidifier

- Osing the Francian Set up the humidifier, and connect to power.

 Press the [Power] button to turn the humidifier ON in Continuous Mist mode. The humidifier's LED light ring will light up BLUE.

 • Press the [Power] button a 2nd time to switch to Intermittent Mist mode.

 • Press the [Power] button a 2nd time to switch to Intermittent Mist mode.
- Press the [Power] button a 3rd time to power the humidifier OFF.

Using the LED Lights

- Press + hold the [Power] button to turn the LED lights ON. They will cycle through different colors.

 Press + hold the [Power] button again to turn the LED lights OFF.

Cleaning and Maintenance When you are finished using the humidifier, unplug and store the cable. Remove the humidifier from water, and allow the sponge wick to dry.

Replacing the Sponge Wick

eplace the sponge wick every 3 months, or when it changes color.

emove the lid, pull out the old sponge wick, and insert a new one. Be careful not to lose the spring that fits under the sponge wick when replacing. Replace the humidifier top
