



Getting Started

Location of Controls





Remove the 2 included sweeping brushes from the box. Press them onto their places on the bottom of the vacuum cleaner, as shown in the **Location of Controls** diagram. Make sure they click on securely, as any gap can cause a malfunction of the vacuum cleaner.

Remove the included mopping strip and attach it to the bottom of the vacuum cleaner using the included adhesive stickers, as shown in the Location of Controls section.

Finally, pull off the protective cap that covers the front wheels on the bottom of the vacuum cleaner.

Charging the Vacuum Cleaner

Plug the small connector of the supplied charging cable into the charging port on the side of the vacuum cleaner. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer or into a compatible USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall

The LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. A full charge takes about 90 minutes.

For best battery life, do not use the vacuum cleaner while

- Charge the vacuum cleaner fully before using. Press the [Power] button to turn ON or OFF.

Using the Vacuum Cleaner

The vacuum cleaner is best used on a smooth surface such as wood, tile or linoleum. It is not recommended to use the vacuum on a rough surface like carpet, or near any stairs or uneven surfaces, which may damage the device.


After charging the vacuum cleaner, place it on the desired surface and turn it on. It will automatically move around on the floor and clean up dust and debris. When you are finished using the vacuum cleaner, turn it off.

Maintenance

Cleaning the Dust Box

The vacuum cleaner collects dust and debris in its dust box on the bottom of the cleaner. To keep the vacuum cleaner in good working order, the dust box should be cleaned regularly.

Remove the dust box by sliding the dust box switch on the bottom of the vacuum clean UP and holding while you slide the dust box out on the left side as shown below.



Once you have removed the dust box, undo the 2 clasps on the front of the box and open the lid. Dump the contents of

Rinse the dust box out with water, and wipe clean with a cloth. When finished, close the lid, and slide the dust box back into the bottom of the vacuum cleaner
