
Cleaning & Maintenance


The vacuum cleaner collects dust and debris in its dust box. To keep the vacuum cleaner in good working order, the dust box & filter should be cleaned regularly.

To clean the dust box & filter:

1. Press down and open the top cover of the



2. Remove the dust box

4. Rinse the dust box. Dry completely with a cloth.



5. The filter should be brushed clean with a soft brush. It is not recommended to get the filter wet.

Finally, replace the filter and snap the dust box back into the vacuum cleaner. Make sure the dust box is re-installed correctly, as incorrect installation can damage the

Additional Cleaning

The vacuum cleaner's wheels, suction port and sweeping brushes will also gather dust and hair regularly. Remove difficult debris by hand if necessary, then brush clean or wipe with a dry cloth.

The outside of the vacuum cleaner, as well as the remote control, may be cleaned with a dry or damp cloth. **Never** bring the vacuum cleaner or remote control into contact with liquid. Never submerge in water or liquid.

If the vacuum cleaner will not be used for a long period of time, it is best stored in an airtight box or bag (not included), away from sources of heat, light, moisture and dust.



Setting Up
1. Remove the 2 included sweeping brushes from the box. Press them onto their places on the bottom of the vacuum cleaner, as shown below. Make sure they click on securely, as any gap can cause a malfunction of the vacuum cleaner.






2. If you wish to use the included mopping pad: Lightly dampen the mopping pad (it should NOT be dripping wet) Press the mopping pad bracket onto the bottom of the section. This accessory is meant for smooth floors only: do

Charging the Vacuum Cleaner Plug the small, round connector of the supplied 5V/1.5A charging adapter into the charging port on the side of the vacuum cleaner. Plug the other end into a wall socket.


 The LED indicator will flash RED when the vacuum cleaner is charging and turn solid **GREEN** when fully

- charged.
 For best battery life, do not use while charging.
- On low power, the LED indicator will flash RED and a tone will be heard Please recharge when this happens.



Powering ON/OFF

Charge the vacuum cleaner fully before using.





• Press the **[Power]** button to power OFF.

 The vacuum cleaner does not have an automatic shutoff function, so you will need to press the [Power] button to turn the vacuum cleaner off when you are done using it. Never leave operating unattended, especially around children or pets. Do not operate while you are not home.



Installing Remote Control Batteries


