

## Getting Started

Location of Controls



Air Intake Vent - Do NOT Block

1. AM/PM Indicator

 ALARM Button: Press: Increase selected digit Press + hold: Turn alarm ON/OFF


- 3. SET Button
- 4. ▼ Button:

Press: Decrease selected digit

- 5. Alarm ON/OFF Indicator
- 6. MODE Button
- 7. Power LED Indicator
- 8. Micro-USB Power Port

### Setting Up the Fan Diffuser


- 1. Remove the lid from the top of the clock.
- 2. Place a few drops of essential oil onto one of the included oil pads.



### Connecting to Power

Insert the small connector of the included USB power cable into the power input port on the back of the clock. Insert the large connector into the USB port on a computer or into a compatible **5V/1A USB Power Adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

The clock display will turn on when the clock is connected to power.



**Note:** When disconnected from power, the clock will remember its set clock time and the state of the diffuser and LED light ON/OFF as long as it has battery remaining. If the battery dies completely, you will need to re-set the clock after recharging the diffuser.


## Setting the Clock & Alarm Times

Connect to power.

- 1. Press the **SET** button. The **time** hour digits will begin blinking.
- 2. Press the ▲▼ buttons to adjust the **time** hour digit. The clock will display the "PM" icon if the hour is in PM.
- 3. Press the **SET** button again. The **time** minute digits will begin blinking.
- 4. Press the  $\overrightarrow{\mathbf{V}}$  buttons to adjust the **time** minute digit.
- When finished adjusting the minutes, press + hold the SET button to save the time. Now, short press the SET button a 3rd time. The alarm hour digit will now begin blinking.
- 6. Press the ▲▼ buttons to adjust the **alarm** hour digit. The clock will display the "PM" icon if the hour is in PM.
- 7. Press the **SET** button again. The **alarm** minute digits will begin blinking.
- 8. Press the **AV** buttons to adjust the **alarm** minute digit.
- 9. When finished adjusting the minutes, **press + hold** the **SET** button to save.

### Turning the Alarm ON/OFF

- Press + hold the ▲ /ALARM button to turn the alarm ON/OFF. The alarm icon on the clock display will light up to indicate that the alarm is activated.
- When the alarm is ringing, press any button under the clock display to SNOOZE for 5 minutes.
- To turn the alarm off completely, press + hold the UP button. The alarm icon on the clock display will turn OFF, indicating that the alarm is OFF.

### Using the Fan Diffuser & LED Lights

- Press the MODE button on the back of the clock to turn the fan diffuser & LED lights ON.
- Press the MODE button again to turn the diffuser & LED lights OFF.



### Cleaning & Storage

Clean the clock with a soft damp or dry cloth ONLY. Never submerge in water, or add water into the diffuser part.

When not in use, the clock should be stored in a cool, dry, dark place. It is best stored in an airtight box or bag (*not included*).
