

Powering the Diffuser

To power the diffuser, insert the pin of the supplied USB power cable into the DC 4.5V power jack on the diffuser, and attach the other connector to the USB port on a computer or 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

NOTE: If using your own USB adapter to power the diffuser, it MUST be a 4.5V - 5V adapter.

If USB power is unavailable, you can insert 3x AAA-sized alkaline batteries (not included) into the battery compartment. When using batteries, make sure that the polarities are properly aligned as indicated on the inside of the battery compartment.

When using batteries, do NOT mix alkaline, carbon-zinc, or any kind of rechargeable batteries. Do not mix different brands of batteries.

Using the Diffuser

- Before connecting to power, add 1-2 drops of essential oil to the oil cup. 2. Connect to power.
- 3. Press the \cline{large} button. The LED

function is active.

Using the Light

 Press the [LAMP] Button to turn the diffuser's light ON/OFF.

When finished, if using USB power, unplug the power cable from the diffuser. Drain any remaining oil from the oil cup, wipe the inside of the up with a damp paper towel, and

If you would like to more thoroughly clean the diffuser, use a small amount of neutral detergent, such as dish soap.

- The amount and intensity of aroma produced will vary. Factors that affect production of aroma can include water type, humidty, temperature, and/or air current.
- Only 100% natural essential oil should be used with this product. Oil containing chemical fragrance, spice, or other impurities, may cause malfunctions. Only use 1 - 2 drops of essential oil.
- ONLY use a 5V USB adapter to power this device with the
- supplied USB power cable.

 When using batteries, if the diffuser's light is dimming or not turning on, you may need to replace the batteries.

 ONLY use AAA-sized alkaline batteries for this device. Do NOT use any rechargeable batteries, carbon-zinc, ni-mh, air and the size of t ni-cad, etc.
- If using batteries, it is recommended that they are removed if the diffuser is not in use for a long period of time.
- When not in use, the diffuser should be stored in a dry, cool location, away from sources of water or heat.
 It is recommended that the diffuser be covered to protect it
- from exposure to dust if it will not be in use for a long period of time.

Precautions and Warnings

- 1. Do not fill the oil cup over MAX level line.
- 2. Do not turn the aroma function on when the oil cup is empty.
 3. Do not touch the inside base of the tank.
- Clean regularly per the Maintenance instructions in this user manual to avoid malfunctions.
- Always unplug the power adapter before maintenance.
 Always pour any remaining oil out of the oil cup and wipe with a clean, dry cloth.
- 7. Essential oils can stain, in the event of a spill or leakage, please wipe away any water or oil with a soft cloth. 8. Do not let aroma blow directly onto furniture, clothing, art,
- or any valuable objects. 9. Keep away from direct sunlight, heat sources, air conditioners,
- 10. Always keep on a stable, flat surface. Do NOT place on a carpet, bed, cushion or other non-flat, non-stable surface.

 11. Keep away from electronic equipment.

 12. Do not tip the product as it may cause oil to enter the
- mechanism and cause malfunction.

 13. Do not use for more than 2 hours at a time.
- 14. Never move the product while in-use.
- 15. Do not touch any part of the product with wet hands.

 16. Keep out of reach of children and pets. Children should
