

Getting Started

Using the Diffuser

Remove the cover from the diffuser. Fill a glass or small pitcher with water and carefully pour




the power jack on the underside of the diffuser. Plug the other end into a 5V USB wall charger or other USB power source.

Press the button on the front of the diffuser to have it begin emitting mist.

With a full tank, the diffuser will operate for up to 3 hours.

Diffusion + Cycling Lights Press the button once to start the diffuser with continuous diffusion.

The LED lights will turn on and cycle through colors.



Diffusion + Solid Color Press a second time to lock the current color into place.


Diffusion + Lights Off Press a third time to turn the lights

Cleaning the Diffuser

When you are finished using the diffuser, unplug the cable, and drain any water remaining in the tank.



Gently wipe the inside of the tank with a clean cloth or rag to remove any leftover oil. Do NOT use any soaps or detergents to clean the water tank.

Carefully clean the nozzle over the ultrasonic pad with a cotton swab.
