- IMPORTANT: Avoid using in conjunction with abrasives to whiten and remove tooth stains.

- IMPORTANT: Do not use high resistance products on teeth and gums.
   Do not use in small children, those who cannot operate on their own or those with a weak oral cavity.
- IMPORTANT: If many of your teeth are being treated or the implant is not firm, do not use it
- . Don't drop it, don't hit it.
- · Don't soak it in water for a long time.



# Getting Started

## Charging the Toothbrush

Turn counterclockwise and remove the waterproof cover at the bottom of the toothbrush, and connect the small connector of the included USB charging cable into the USB charging port.

Connect the larger connect to a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer, or a **5V USB wall adapter** (not included).

Once the toothbrush is fully charged, remove the USB charging cable from the toothbrush. And put the waterproof cover back on the bottom and turn it clockwise to tightly close it.

## Using the Toothbrush

This product has 6 working modes. Choose the desired working mode that best suits you.

- · Whitening Mode: Whitening teeth and restoring beauty
- · Massage Mode: Frequency conversion impact massage gum
- Cleaning Mode: Cleaning mouth with sound wave vibration
- Soft Mode: Gentle care for sensitive toothbrush
- Polish Mode: Polished and polished teeth
- Gum Protection Mode: Clean the four corners, clean the mouth

### Attaching a brush

Place the head at a 45° angle and turn it clockwise to align. To remove the head, turn it counterclockwise and then pull it up.



# Dental Cleaning

- 1. Moisten the brush and apply a suitable amount of toothpaste.
- 2. Place the brush on the teeth at a 45° angle to the gum line.
- 3. Press the power switch to start brusing your teeth.

Note: Gently move the brush to the part to be cleaned, and the pressure should be within 150g (very low). The toothbrushes use the highfrequency vibration to clean the oral cavity, so the pressure required





45° angle for the aumline.

when brushing your teeth is smaller than that of normal toothbrushes. About 1/8 of the pressure of normal brushes is sufficient

The dentist recommends that the oral cavity be divided into four areas. During the brushing process, move the toothbrush slowly to make sure each area has a cleaning time of approximately 30 seconds. This machine does not have a 15-second area reminder function and will stop for 0.5 every 15 seconds. To remind you to change areas to brush your teeth.

## Facial Cleansing

- 1. Lather your face and use the Silicone Brush Head to thoroughly cleanse vour skin.
- 2. Press the power siwtch to turn it on and choose your suitable working mode
- 3. Use the cleansing brush to trace small circles all over the face. emphasizing the oiliest areas that tend to produce more blackheads. Three minutes will be enough.

## Facelift

- Apply your facial cream or facial treatment on your face, and attach the Facelift Bar Head to the toothbrush.
- Press the power switch to turn it on and choose your suitable working mode.

# Cleaning

Wipe the outside of the toothbrush with a damp cloth or sponge. Do NOT submerge in water or other liquid.

# Storing

Store in a cool, dry place away from sunlight, heat, wind and humidity.
