Using the Massager

Apply the massager head to your body, moving the massager head around the area in a circular motion.

Be careful not to press down too hard or focus on one area for too long, especially when using on the neck or lower back area as these areas can be more sensitive and susceptible to injury than other parts of the body.



Using the Heat

Move the [Heat] switch to the ON position to turn the heat ON. The red light on the massage head will light up RED to indicate that the heat is on.

The massager may take several minutes to heat up once powered on.

Caution: The heat function of this product should not be used by people who are sensitive to heat or anyone who is unable to properly operate the controls. Children and persons with reduced ability to operate the controls should not use the product except under strict supervision.

Storing the Massager

When not using the massager for a long period of time, it is best to store it. Store in a dry, cool location, away from sources of water or heat. It is best stored in a secure box or in an airtight bag to keep it free of dust.

Cleaning the Massager

Unplug the massager and let cool down.

Wipe down the massager with a DAMP (not WET) cloth or sponge. Do NOT use any abrasive cleaning solutions such as bleach. Do NOT let the plug get wet. If it does get wet, do NOT plug the massager back in.








Setting Up the Massager
