

## Location of Controls



- Charging the Vacuum Cleaner

  1. Plug the USB-C connector (smaller) of the included USB-C charging cable into the USB-C charging port on the acuum cleaner.
- 2. Plug the USB connector (larger) into a USB powe such as the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V USB** adapter (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

  3. The LED indicator on the vacuum cleaner will turn RED
- when it is charging and turn OFF when it is fully charged.


## Using the Crevice Attachment

To use the crevice attachment, simply press the smaller end of the attachment into the opening on the end of the vacuum cleaner. It should snap in place.

Push and pull the end piece on the attachment to adjust.

## Using the Vacuum Cleaner

Charge the vacuum cleaner & install the crevice attachment if



- Press + hold the [Power] button to power ON in Normal Power mode. From full battery, the cleaner can vacuum for about 20 minutes on Normal Power
- After powering ON, quick press the [Power] button to switch to High Power. From full battery, the cleaner can acuum for about 15 minutes on High Power.
- · Quick press the [Power] button a 2nd time to power OFF.
