Playing Music

To listen to music on your headphones, make sure they are paired to a Bluetoothenabled device or connected via 3.5 mm auxiliary input.

Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Press and hold the [ტ] button for **7 seconds** to set the headphones into pairing mode. A tone will be heard and the LED indicator will flash GREEN and BLUE
- Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **PBBTH11** from the list of found devices.

 3. Once successfully paired, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will turn
- solid BLUE.

Controlling Playback & Volume

- Press the [Φ] button to pause/resume media playback.
 Press the [+] and [] buttons to skip tracks.
- Press and hold the [+] and [] buttons to adjust volume. A tone will be heard if trying to increase the volume past the maximum level.

Connecting with the 3.5 mm Input

- Insert one connector of the supplied 3.5 mm auxiliary audio cable into the 3.5 mm auxiliary audio input jack.
- Insert the other connector of the cable into the audio output or headphone jack of your media-playing device.
- 3. Adjust playback with the controls on your media-playing device.

Getting Started

Charging the Headphones

Attach the small connector of the supplied micro-USB cable to the USB charging port on the side of the left earcup. Attach the large connector to the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The LED indicator will *turn RED* while charging and turn off when fully charged. When low on power, a voice will be heard, indicating that the headphones should be charged.

Power ON/OFF

- Press and hold the [()] button to power the headphones ON/OFF.
- When powered ON, the headphones will automatically reconnect to the device they were most recently paired to, so long as that device is within connection range (30 ft.) and Bluetooth is enabled.

Phone Calls

- \bullet Quick press the [\circlearrowleft] button to answer an incoming phone call. Quick press again to end the phone call.
- Press and hole the [\circlearrowleft] button for 2 sec. to send an incoming phone call straight to voicemail.
