

### Connecting to Two Bluetooth Devices

To connect two Bluetooth devices to the same headset:

1. Connect the first Bluetooth device to the headset following the instructions in the **Bluetooth Pairing** section of this manual.
2. On the second Bluetooth device, open Bluetooth Settings, and search for new devices. Select **PBBTH50** from the list of found devices.
3. Return to the first Bluetooth device's Bluetooth Settings. Select **PBBTH50** again.
4. The headset should now be connected to both Bluetooth devices.







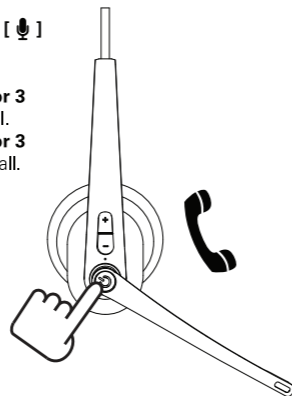
When the headset is paired to two devices:

- The headset can intercept and answer a phone call that comes through on either device.
- Audio can only be listened to on one device at a time. If you wish to play audio from the other device, pause or turn off audio on the first device, and begin audio playback on the second device.

### Phone Calls

To use the phone functions on the headset, you must be connected to a Bluetooth-enabled device.

- Press the [  ] button to **answer** an incoming phone call. Playback will automatically pause
- While on a phone call, press the [  ] button to **mute/unmute** the microphone.
- **Press + hold** the [  ] button for **3 seconds to hang up** a phone call.
- **Press + hold** the [  ] button for **3 seconds to reject** an incoming call.

## Before You Begin

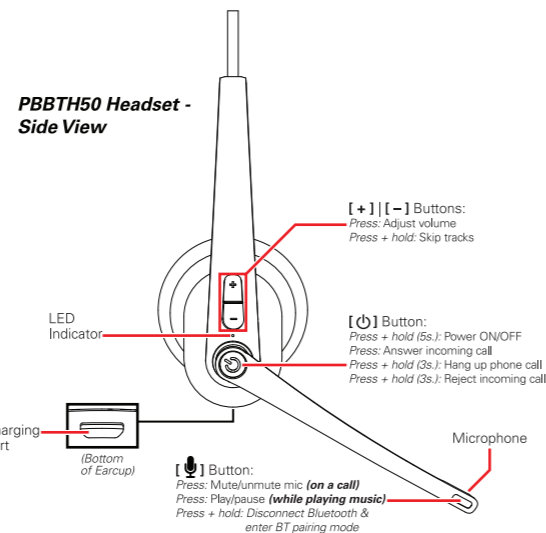

### Location of Controls



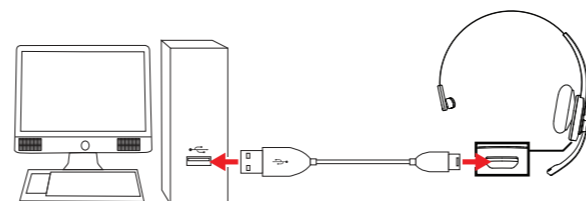
## Getting Started

### Charging the Headset

Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the charging port on the headset earcup. Plug the large connector into a USB power source such as the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V/1A USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The headset LED indicator will **slowly flash RED** while charging and **turn solid RED** when fully charged.

On low battery, a red light will flash and the headset will automatically power OFF. Please recharge when this happens.



### Powering ON/OFF

- **Press + hold** the [⏻] button for **5 seconds** to power the headset ON or OFF.
- When powered on, a voice will be heard and the headset will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. They may automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device with **Bluetooth enabled**.
- **Note:** The headset will automatically power OFF if it is not paired to a Bluetooth device after 30 minutes.

### Playing Music

To listen to music on the headset, you must be paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device. Consult the **Bluetooth Pairing** below for further instruction.

### Adjusting Volume & Playback

- While playing music, press the [🔇] button to pause and resume playback.
- Press the [+] and [-] buttons to adjust volume.
- **Press + hold** the [+] and [-] buttons to skip tracks.

### Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the headset ON. The LED indicator will **flash BLUE quickly**.
2. Go into your device's Bluetooth Settings, and search for new devices. When it appears, select **PBBTH50** from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, the LED indicator will **turn solid BLUE**.

In Bluetooth mode, playback and volume can be adjusted with the on-ear controls listed in the **Adjusting Volume & Playback** section above, or with your paired device.

- **Press + hold** the [🔇] button to disconnect a Bluetooth pairing and re-enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The LED indicator will **flash BLUE quickly** when the headset is ready to pair again.

### Muting/Unmuting the Microphone

- Press the [🔇] button to mute or unmute the microphone while on a call, or while using the mic.
- **Note:** If you are listening to music on the headset, pressing the [🔇] button will pause and resume audio playback.
