


Remove the battery cover from the bottom of the keyboard/mouse.2. Install new Alkaline batteries into the battery compartment of the keyboard or mouse, following the polarity (+/-) diagram in the compartment. Do not mix old and new batteries, or mix different brands or types of battery.<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The keyboard takes 1 AA-sized battery (not included)• The mouse takes 2 AAA-sized batteries (not included)3. Replace the battery cover back onto the battery compartment. <p>Setup Plug the included USB receiver into any of the USB ports (Type-A) on the front or back of your computer.</p>  <p>Your computer should automatically detect and install the devices after batteries are installed and the USB receiver is connected.</p> <p>If your computer does not automatically connect to the keyboard or mouse, try restarting your computer or checking the devices settings in your computer's Settings or System Preferences panel, or try the steps in the Troubleshooting section on the next page.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Troubleshooting</p> <p>The mouse and keyboard should both automatically connect to the single USB receiver that you plug into the computer, and connect to the computer.</p> <p>If the keyboard and mouse are not both connecting, try the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Unplug the USB receiver from your computer.2. Remove the batteries from both the keyboard and mouse.3. Re-install the keyboard and mouse's batteries at the same time.4. Press Esc + Q together at the same time on the keyboard.5.
