


Getting Started

Insert the mouse's USB connector into a USB port on your computer. The mouse will automatically install any additional drivers required to



To turn the LED lights on/off, press the DPI and ∇ buttons at the same time.

Adjusting Sensitivity (DPI)

The PBGA13 has 4 levels of sensitivity that can be adjusted with the [△] and [▽] buttons.

The mouse will illuminate a different color for each level of sensitivity:

Color	DPi	
Blue	1200	Low Sensitivity
Dark PinkLight Pink	2400	
Light Pink	4800	
Purple	7200	High Sensitivity

Using the Fire Button The PBGA13 is equipped with a Fire Button (see highlighted button, to the left).

When pressed, the mouse will register a double-click of the Left Click button.
