Getting Started

Connecting to Gaming Consoles

Note: Some Xbox One controllers may not have a 3.5 mm headphone jack and will require an additional adapter (*not included*).

PC & Laptop

1. Insert the microphone and headphone 3.5 mm connectors into a cable adapter (*not included*) such as shown on the previous page.
2. Plug the adapter's 3.5 mm pin into your gaming controller or audio jack (please consult your console's instructions for more information).
3. Insert the USB connector into a **5V USB** power source to use the headset lights.
