The mouse will automatically install any additional drivers required to operate.</p> <p>When plugged in, the LEDs on the mouse will automatically turn on whenever your computer is powered on.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Press for a double-click!</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Press to adjust sensitivity!</p> <p>800 DPI (<i>Low sensitivity</i>) 1200 DPI 2400 DPI 3200 DPI (<i>High sensitivity</i>)</p> <p><b>Adjusting Sensitivity (DPI)</b> The PBGK80 has 4 levels of sensitivity that can be adjusted with the <b>[DPI]</b> button.
