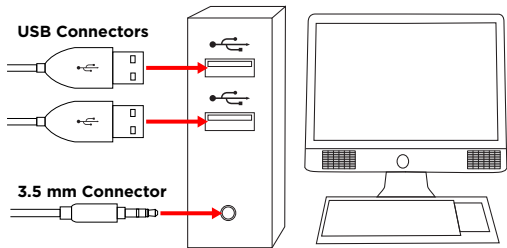

Getting Started

Setup

Plug the keyboard and mouse's attached USB connectors into any of the USB ports (Type-A) on the front or back of your computer. Plug the headphones' 3.5 mm connector into the 3.5 mm port on your computer.



The keyboard, mouse and headphones should not require any special installation or software to connect to your computer. Your computer should automatically detect and install them, and their lights should automatically turn on.

If your computer does not automatically connect to the keyboard or mouse, try restarting your computer or checking the device settings in your computer's **Settings** or **System Preferences** panel.

Using the Mouse

- Switch between the 4 different sensitivity options (800, 1600, 2400, 3600) of the mouse by pressing the **[DPI]** button in the center of the mouse.
- Press the **[Forward]** and **[Backward]** Keys on the left side of the mouse to skip forward and backward on web pages.
