Using the LED Lightstrip (cont'd)

Lightstrip Setup (cont'd)

Once you have the lightstrip set up in the desired location and connected to a power source, peel the backing off the lightstrip's adhesive and press firmly onto the desired surface.

Using the LED Lightstrip

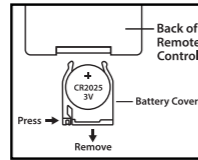
Remove the battery tab from the included remote control, and use the remote control to power the lightstrip ON/OFF and adjust the color, brightness and light mode of the lightstrip.

- For a solid color, select [RED], [GREEN], [BLUE], [ORANGE], [YELLOW], [CYAN] or [PURPLE].
- For a dynamic light mode, press a [JUMP] or [FADE] button.
- For a sound-responsive mode, press a [♪] button.



Replacing the Remote Control Battery

- Remove the battery cover on the bottom of the remote control, as shown at right.
- Remove the old battery and place a new CR2025 battery (*not included*) in the tray.
- Replace the battery cover.

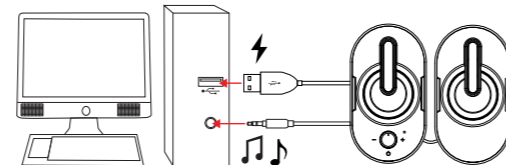
Using the Speakers

Speakers Setup

Choose a location for the speakers near your computer or near a USB (Type-A) power source.

To power the speakers, plug their attached USB connector into a USB (Type-A) port on a computer or a compatible **5V USB adapter** (*not included*) and plug into a wall socket.

To play audio on the speakers, plug the speakers' attached 3.5 mm connector into a 3.5 mm audio output port on your computer or audio device.



Using the Speakers

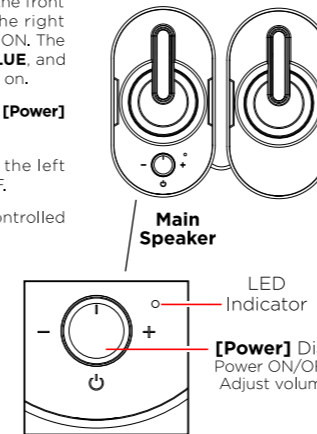
Set up the speakers.

Turn the [Power] dial on the front of the main speaker to the right until it clicks to power ON. The LED indicator will turn **BLUE**, and the speaker lights will turn on.

When powered on, turn the [Power] dial to adjust volume.

Turn the [Power] dial to the left until it clicks to power OFF.

Audio playback will be controlled by your connected device.



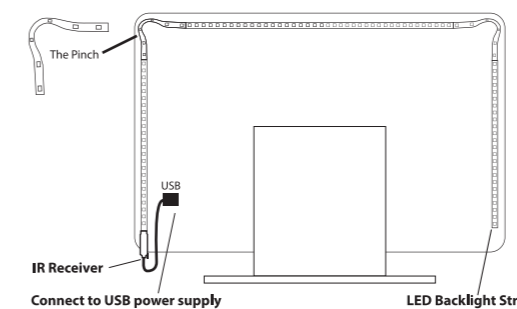
Using the Speakers (cont'd)

Lightstrip Setup

Select a location for the lightstrip near a power source such as the USB port on a computer or a compatible **5V USB adapter** (*not included*).

The sound-responsive lightstrip will react to the beat of your audio when played within ~5 m (16 ft) of the lightstrip's IR receiver. For best results, place the lightstrip and the audio source close together, and turn the audio volume up.

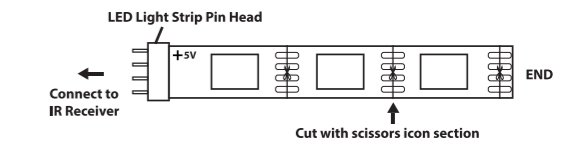
Placement Example: Back of Computer Screen



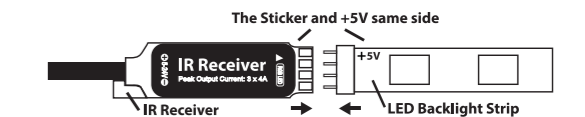
Using the LED Lightstrip (cont'd)

Lightstrip Setup (cont'd)

If necessary, you can cut the lightstrip to shorten it. Using a pair of scissors, cut along one of the marked lines on the side away from the pin head side of the lightstrip, as shown below.



Connect the lightstrip to the IR receiver, as shown below. If the LED lightstrip does not power on, try flipping the connector the other way and plugging in.



For best results, place the lightstrip's IR receiver within clear view of where the lightstrip remote control will be used, and away from any other IR receiver, such as on a computer or television.
