



Getting Started


Charging the Case

Insert the small connector of the supplied micro-USB charging cable into the micro-USB charging port on the back of the charging case. Insert the large connector into the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket. The case-charging LED indicator will **flash RED** while charging and **turn solid RED** when fully charged.

Charging the Earbuds

Make sure that the charging case is fully charged.

Open the charging case and insert the stem of each earbud into the case's charging port. Gently press down until they "clip" into place and feel secure.



Powering ON/OFF

- Press + hold both earbuds' [Multi] buttons to power them ON. The earbuds will pair to each other, and enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
- Power the earbuds OFF by pressing + holding both earbuds'
 [Multi] buttons, or by inserting them into their case.

Bluetooth Pairing

- Power both earbuds ON. The earbuds' LED indicators will briefly flash RED and BLUE.
- After a moment, one of the earbuds will slowly flash RED and BLUE and the other earbud's LED indicator will slowly blink BLUE.
- 3. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. Select **TUTWS10** when it appears on the list of found devices.
- 4. Once paired to your device, both earbuds' LED indicators will turn OFF.

Re-Pairing the Earbuds

- 1. Start with both earbuds powered OFF.
- Press and hold both earbuds' [Multi] buttons to power them both ON at the same time. Both earbuds' LED indicators will briefly flash RED and BLUE.
- After a moment, one earbud will slowly flash RED and BLUE, and the other earbud's LED indicator will slowly blink BLUE.

Playing Music

To enjoy music wirelessly on your earbuds, make sure they are properly paired to your Bluetooth-enabled device.

Once paired, playback is controlled through your paired device or with the control listed below.

- Press the [Multi] button to pause or resume playback.
- Double press the [Multi] button on the left earbud to skip to the previous track.
- Double press the [Multi] button on the right earbud to skip to the next track.

Answering/Ending Phone Calls

- Press either [Multi] button to answer an incoming call.
- Press either [Multi] button to end a phone call.
- Triple press the [Multi] button to dial the last outgoing number.
