Powering the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the included power cable into the power port on the back of the speaker. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer, or into a 5V USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

Powering ON/OFF

- Move the [Power] switch on the back of the speaker to power ON and OFF.
- When powered ON, the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and will automatically re-pair to any available previously-paired device nearby.



Getting Started

- Bluetooth Pairing
 1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
- 2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When the list appears, select TXBTSTARSPK-FB from the found devices. 3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard, and you will be able to play
- music on the speaker.

All playback and volume adjustment will be controlled by your paired device.

Using the Star Projector

The star projector lights will automatically power ON when the speaker is powered ON, and OFF when the speaker is powered off.

For best results, place further away from the surface you wish to project on.
