- Only use the device according to the instructions in this manual. Never use the device for anything other than its intended purpose.
- Do not open this product. Do not attempt to modify or repair the unit. Doing so risks shock, burn and injury.
- Do not expose the unit to extreme temperatures (heat or cold), open flames, flammable items, or humid or wet conditions.
- DO NOT submerge or rinse under running water.
- Do not use the refrigerator to preserve sensitive medication.
- Always keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction. Do not allow any ports, vents, inputs or connectors of the device or power adapter to be exposed to dust or water, or come into contact with any conductive materials such as liquids, metallic powders, etc.
- Do not use in a poorly ventilated area. Allow at least 2 inches of distance from the back and sides of the device to allow proper air circulation and heat dispersal.
- To ensure optimal performance, keep the cooler/warmer unit's fans clear of dirt and debris. Stuck fans will overheat the unit and can pose a potential fire hazard.
- Do not place any cloth or paper products on the unit.
- This unit ONLY works on 110-240V power supply.
- When packing the unit, do not place upside-down.
- DO NOT use other electrical appliances inside the storage compartments of the appliance.
- When plugging in the unit, ensure that the power cord is inserted tightly into the socket. A loose socket can cause damage or fire.
- If the supplied power adapter is damaged in any way, DO NOT attempt to repair it. Damaged power cords must be replaced by the manufacturer.

Location of Controls

Connecting to Power

Choose a location for the refrigerator near a wall power outlet or a 12V DC automobile auxiliary power outlet (cigarette lighter), away from sources of light, heat, moisture and dust. Make sure there are at least 2 inches of distance on every side of the refrigerator so it can properly ventilate.

Connecting to Wall Power
Plug the two-pin connector of the included power adapter into the AC power port on the back of the refrigerator. Plug the electrical plug into a wall outlet.

Using the Car Adapter
Plug the 2-pin connector of the included car adapter into the DC power port on the back of the refrigerator. Plug the car adapter's 12V plug into the 12V DC automobile auxiliary power outlet (cigarette lighter) of your car.

Warning:

- Use only with a 12-Volt outlet. Do NOT connect directly to the 24-Volt outlet of a heavy duty vehicle.
- Do not leave the refrigerator plugged in for a long time while the engine is not running, as this can drain the car's battery.
- Never leave the refrigerator running in a poorly ventilated area such as a car's trunk.

Using the Refrigerator

Set up the refrigerator and connect to power.

For best results, cool or warm your beauty products before placing them in the refrigerator. The refrigerator is not designed to cool down or heat up products, but to keep them cool or warm.

Move the **[Mode]** Switch on the back of refrigerator to select a temperature mode.

- Select the "COOL" position for cooling mode. The COOL Indicator light on the back of the refrigerator will light up **GREEN**.
- Select the "WARM" position for warming mode. The WARM Indicator light on the back of the refrigerator will light up **RED**.
- If you are switching between temperature modes, be sure turn the refrigerator OFF for 30 minutes in between the switch.

Cleaning & Maintenance
Disconnect the refrigerator from power before performing any cleaning or maintenance on it.

The air intake vent on the back of the refrigerator should be cleaned with a vacuum or brush monthly.

The surfaces of the refrigerator can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild cleaner.

- Never submerge the refrigerator in water or liquid.
- Never allow any ports, vents or connectors to come into contact with liquid. Do not touch with wet hands.
- Allow the refrigerator to dry completely before connecting to power again.

Storage
When the refrigerator will not be used for a long period of time, it should be stored away.

It is best stored in an airtight box or bag (*not included*), away from sources of light, heat, dust and moisture.
