Troubleshooting

Common Issues & Solutions

The vacuum cleaner does not work.

- Make sure the vacuum cleaner is fully charged. If the battery is dead or low on power, this can cause the vacuum cleaner to dysfunction or not work. See the **Charging the Vacuum** Cleaner section of this manual for detailed instructions
- Check that it is powered on. The [Power] switch on the bottom should be flipped to the ON position, and you need. to press the [Power] button on the top of the vacuum cleaner to start cleaning.

The cleaning is weak.

- Power OFF. Check that the dust box, suction port and sweeping brushes have all been cleaned, and are free of debris. Check that the filter does not need to be replaced. 2. Check that vacuum cleaner is fully charged.
- The vacuum cleaner won't charge.
- Make sure both connectors of the charging cable are correctly connected Both connect in only one direction.
- Make sure that the cable is not damaged. If the cable is damaged, do NOT attempt to charge. Contact the manufacturer immediately.
- Make sure that you are plugged into a compatible 5-Volt/1-Amp USB-A power source. If the power source is not working or connecting correctly with the device, the
- vacuum cleaner won't charge.

 4. Make sure you have waited several minutes after plugging the vacuum cleaner in to see that it won't start chargi The LED indicator will **light up RED** when the vacuum cleaner is charging.



Getting Started

- Setting Up

 1. Remove the 2 included sweeping brushes from the box. Press them onto their places on the bottom of the vacuum cleaner, as shown in the Location of Controls diagram. Make sure they click on securely, as any gap can cause a malfunction of the vacuum
- 2. Remove the included mopping cloth and attach it to the bottom of the vacuum cleaner using the included adhesive stickers, as shown in the **Location of Controls** section.
- 3. Pull off the protective cap that covers the front wheels on the bottom of the vacuum cleaner.

Charging the Vacuum Cleaner
Plug the small connector of the supplied charging cable into the charging port on the side of the vacuum cleaner. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer or into a compatible USB adapter (not included) and plug into a wall socket

The LED indicator will **turn RED** while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. A full charge takes about 90 minutes.

For best battery life, do not use the vacuum cleaner while charging.



Using the Vacuum Cleaner

The vacuum cleaner is best used on a smooth surface such as wood, tile or linoleum. It is not recommended to use the vacuum on a rough surface like carpet, or near any stairs or uneven surfaces, which may damage the device. **Caution**: Never allow the vacuum cleaner itself to come near water or any other liquid, and do not touch it with wet hands. Doing so risks shock, injury or damage.

Charge the vacuum cleaner, and place on the desired surface. Turn it ON as described above. The LED indicator will **turn solid BLUE**, and it will begin moving around and cleaning up dust and debris.


Cleaning the Dust Box

The vacuum cleaner collects dust and debris in its dust box on the bottom of the cleaner. To keep the vacuum cleaner in good working order, the dust box should be cleaned regularly.
