## Playing Music

To listen to music on your headphones, make sure they are paired to a Bluetoothenabled device or connected via 3.5 mm auxiliary input.

#### Bluetooth Pairing

- Power the headphones ON. A tone will be heard and the LED indicator will flash RED and BLUE
- Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **PBT99** from the list of found devices.
- 3. Once successfully paired, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will turn solid BLUE

### Controlling Playback & Volume
