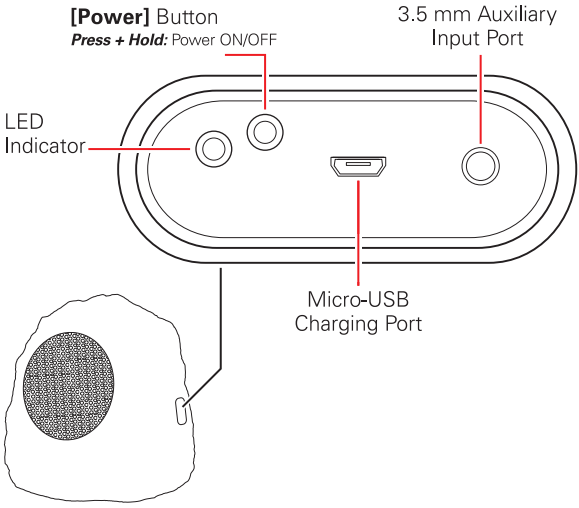

This means that it is protected against water splashes from all directions. It is NOT protected from submersion in water, such as flooding. Always make sure that the protective rubber seal is completely covering the control panel before using the speaker in wet conditions. Never charge the speaker or use the AUX port in wet conditions. Charging the Speaker Undo the protective rubber seal on the side of the speaker and plug the small connector of the supplied charging cable into the micro-USB charging port. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer or a 5V USB adapter (<i>not included</i>) and plug into an electrical outlet. The LED indicator will turn RED while the speaker is charging and turn OFF when the speaker is fully charged. On low power, a tone will be heard indicating that the speaker needs to be charged. Powering ON/OFF • Press and hold the [Power] button to power the speaker ON and OFF. The [Power] button can be pressed through the protective rubber seal. • When powered ON, the speaker will automatically reconnect to the Bluetooth device it was most recently paired to, so long as that device is within connection range (30 ft.) and Bluetooth is enabled. • The speaker will automatically power OFF after 10 minutes not in use.	Playing Music To listen to music on your speaker, make sure it is paired to a Bluetooth-enabled device or connected via the 3.5 mm auxiliary input port. See the Bluetooth Pairing and Connecting to the AUX Port sections of this manual for detailed instruction. All playback and volume will be controlled by your connected device. Bluetooth Pairing 1. Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard, and the LED indicator will flash BLUE. 2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select PBT650 from the list of found devices. 3. Once successfully paired, a tone will be heard and the LED indicator will turn solid BLUE. Connecting to the AUX Port Warning: Never use the auxiliary input function around water or liquid. The protective rubber seal should completely cover the control panel when using in wet conditions. Plug one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary audio cable (<i>not included</i>) into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input port on the speaker. Plug the other connector into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm audio output on your media-playing device. The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode when a cable is plugged into the auxiliary input port.
