





Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the included micro-USB charging cable into the DC 5V charging port on the back panel of the speaker. Plug the large connector into a USB power source such as the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

The charging LED indicator on the back of the speaker will **turn RED** while charging and **turn GREEN** when fully charged. When the speaker is low on power, a tone will be heard indicating that it needs to be recharged.

Powering ON/OFF

- Turn the [VOLUME/POWER] dial clockwise until it
- clicks to power the speaker ON.

 When powered ON, a tone will be heard. The speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and may automatically re-pair to any available previously-paired
