

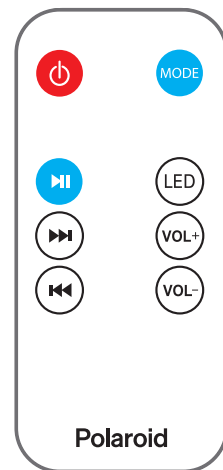

## Using the Remote Control

- **[⏻]** Button: Enter/leave standby mode
- **[MODE]** Button: Change input mode
- **[▶||]** Button: Pause/resume playback
- **[LED]** Button: Change LED light mode
- **[▶▶]** Button: Skip to next track
- **[◀◀]** Button: Skip to previous track
- **[VOL+]** Button: Increase volume
- **[VOL-]** Button: Decrease volume

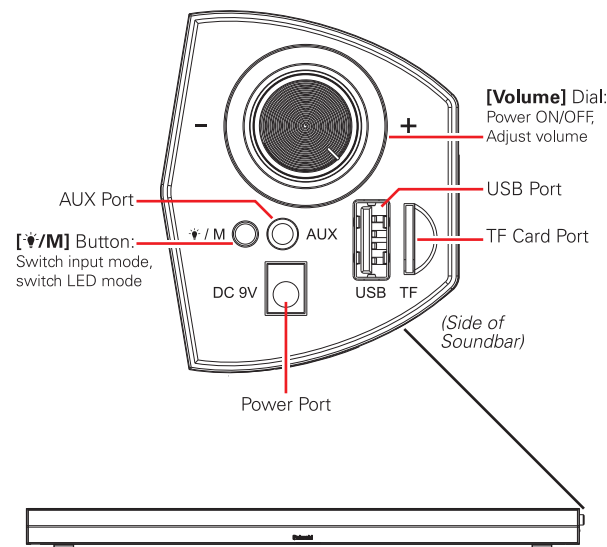

## Getting Started

### Wall Mounting the Soundbar

1. Remove the soundbar and its contents from packaging.
2. Using a pencil, mark two spots on a wall measuring 31.5 inches apart.
3. If installing to a wooden surface, hammer a nail, or drive or drill a mounting screw (*mounting materials not included*) into the wall at each marked location. If installing to drywall or a brick surface, you may need to install plastic anchors to properly secure the mounting screws.
4. Place and hang the soundbar from its mounting holes on the back onto the installed mounting nails or screws.

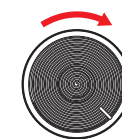


### Connecting to Power

Plug the pin of the supplied power adapter into the DC 9V power port on the side of the soundbar. Plug into an electrical outlet.

### Powering ON/OFF

- Turn the **[Volume]** dial *to the right* until it clicks to power ON. A tone will be heard, and the soundbar will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. It will automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device with Bluetooth enabled.
- Turn the **[Volume]** dial *to the left* until it clicks to power OFF.



### Changing Input Modes

Press the **[M/M]** button on the side of the soundbar or the **[MODE]** button on the remote control to switch input modes.

A USB device or TF card must be inserted to switch to these modes.

### Adjusting Volume

Adjust volume by turning the **[Volume]** dial on the soundbar, or use the controls on your connected device.

### Using the LED Lights

- Press + hold the **[M/M]** button on the soundbar or press the **[LED]** button on the remote control to flip through LED light modes.

### Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the soundbar ON. A tone will be heard and soundbar will enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **PBT3059** from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and you will be able to play music on the soundbar.

In Bluetooth mode, playback will be controlled by your paired device. Volume can be adjusted with the dial on the soundbar or with the controls on your paired device.

### Using the 3.5 mm AUX Input

Insert one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (*not included*) into the 3.5 mm aux input port on the soundbar.

Insert the other connector into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm aux output port on your media-playing device. The soundbar will automatically switch to AUX mode.

In AUX mode, all playback will be controlled by your connected device.

### USB Device and TF Card Input

Insert a USB device, such as a USB flash drive, or micro SD/TF card into the USB or TF card input ports on the side of the soundbar.

**Note:** To listen to music on your USB device, you may need to have files stored in the root folder of the device. Check your USB device's manufacturer information for more details.

If the soundbar does not automatically switch to the correct mode, press the **[M/M]** or **[MODE]** button until you enter USB or TF card mode. The speaker will automatically begin playing music off the device.

In USB and TF mode, playback and volume adjustment will be controlled with the buttons on the remote control. See the **Using the Remote Control** section on the next page of this manual for details.
