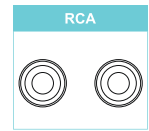
## Bluetooth Pairing

1. Connect the system to power, and power ON. Enter Bluetooth mode. The screen on the front of the soundbar will display "bBLUE."
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **PBT9076** from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and you will be able to play music on the sound system.

In Bluetooth mode, playback & volume can be controlled by your paired device, by the buttons on the speaker, or by the remote control.

## Using the RCA Ports

1. Plug the red and white connectors of the included RCA cable into the corresponding ports on the back of the soundbar.
2. Plug the AUX (smaller) connector into the headphone jack or AUX output port on your media-playing device.
3. Switch to RCA mode. The soundbar will display "LINE."



**Note:** You can connect any device with RCA jacks by plugging them into the RCA ports on the soundbar.

## Using the AUX Port

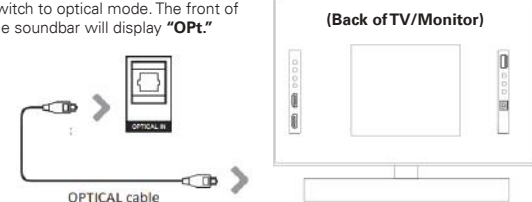
1. Plug one connector of the included AUX cable into the AUX port on the back of the soundbar.
2. Plug the other connector into the headphone jack or AUX output port on your media-playing device.
3. Switch to AUX mode. The soundbar will display "AUX."



**Note:** You can connect any device with a 3.5 mm AUX jack by plugging it into the AUX ports on the soundbar.

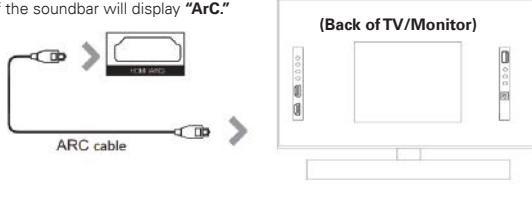
## Using the Optical Input Port

1. Plug one connector of the included optical cable into the optical port on the back of the soundbar. Plug the other connector into your device.
2. Switch to optical mode. The front of the soundbar will display "OPT."



## Using the HDMI (ARC) Port

1. Plug your device's HDMI (ARC) jack (**not included**) into the HDMI (ARC) port on the back of the soundbar.
2. Switch to HDMI/ARC mode. The front of the soundbar will display "ARC."



## USB Device Input

1. Insert a USB device, such as a USB flash drive into the USB device input on the back of the soundbar.

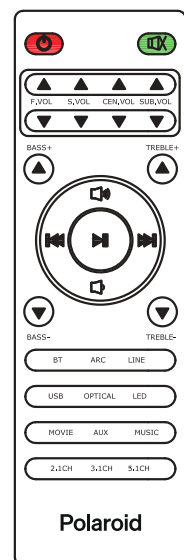
**Note:** To listen to music on your USB device, you may need to have files stored in the root folder of the device. Check your USB device's manufacturer information for more details.

If the soundbar does not automatically switch to the correct mode, switch to USB mode using the remote control or the buttons on the speaker. The soundbar will display "USB" and the sound system will automatically begin playing music off the device.

In USB mode, playback and volume adjustment will be controlled with the buttons on the remote control. See the **Remote Control** section on the next page for details.

## Remote Control

1. **Power** Button: Enter/exit standby
2. **LED** Button: Mute/unmute
3. **F.VOL** **▲▼** Buttons: Adjust vol. of front tone (s.bar)
4. **S.VOL** **▲▼** Buttons: Adjust vol. of sat. speakers
5. **CEN.VOL** **▲▼** Buttons: Adjust center tone vol.
6. **SUB.VOL** **▲▼** Buttons: Adjust subwoofer vol. (s.bar)
7. **BASS** **▲▼** Buttons: Adjust bass
8. **TREBLE** **▲▼** Buttons: Adjust treble
9. **Q** Button: Increase overall volume
10. **Q** Button: Decrease overall volume
11. **⏮** **⏭** Buttons: Skip tracks
12. **⏸** Button: Pause/resume playback
13. **BT** Button: Switch to Bluetooth mode
14. **ARC** Button: Switch to HDMI (ARC) mode
15. **LINE** Button: Switch to RCA mode
16. **USB** Button: Switch to USB mode
17. **OPTICAL** Button: Switch to Optical mode
18. **LED** Button: Turn LED screen ON/OFF
19. **MOVIE** Button: Sound mode for movie watching
20. **AUX** Button: Switch to AUX mode
21. **MUSIC** Button: Sound mode for music listening
22. **2.1CH** Button: Enter soundbar only mode
23. **3.1CH** Button: Enter soundbar & subwoofer only mode
24. **5.1CH** Button: Use entire sound system

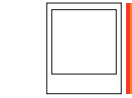

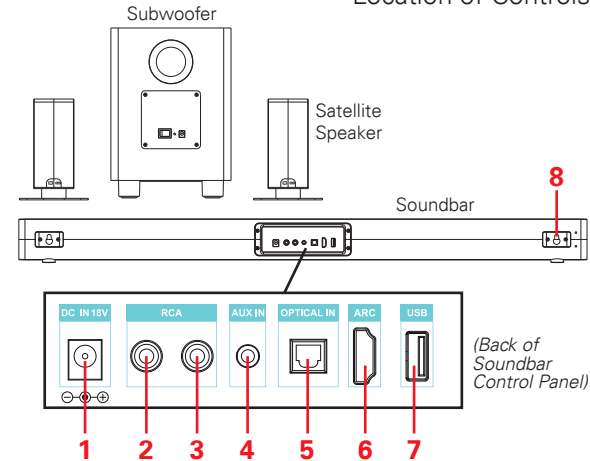

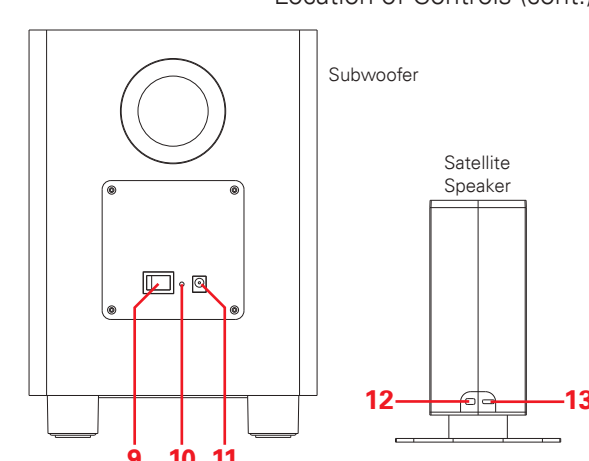

## Location of Controls



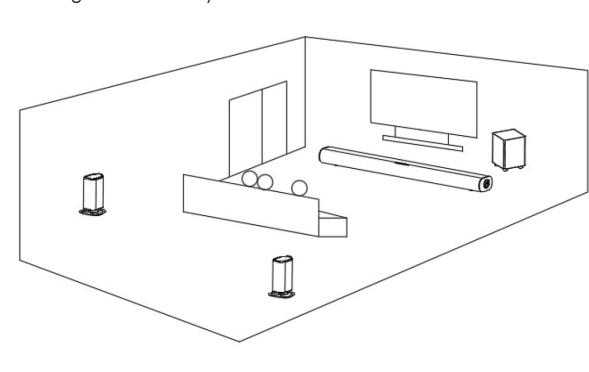
1. Power Input Port

13. Sat. Speaker Charging Port

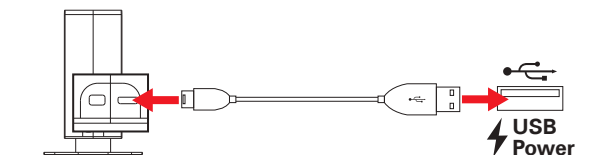
## Placing the Sound System



- The soundbar should be placed directly in front of you, above or below your TV or display.
- The subwoofer should be placed near the soundbar, centered or on the left or right side.
- The two satellite speakers should go at the back of the room, one on each side.
- For best results, the satellite speakers should be placed within 7 meters (23 feet) of the soundbar and subwoofer.

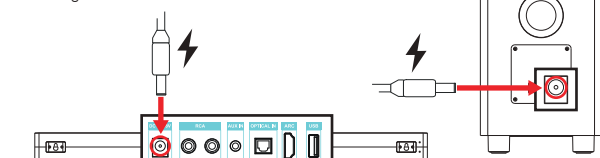
## Charging the Satellite Speakers

1. Plug the micro-USB (smaller) connectors of the included USB charging cables into the charging ports on the satellite speakers.
2. Plug the USB (larger) connectors into USB power ports, such as the USB ports on a computer, or **5V USB power adapters** (not included).
3. LED indicators on the front of the speakers will light up RED while they are charging and turn OFF when they are fully charged.
4. You are now ready to mount the soundbar to the wall. Please store the extra bases and caps in a safe location for use later.



## Connecting the Soundbar & Subwoofer to Power

1. Plug the pins of the included power adapters into the power ports on the soundbar and subwoofer.
2. Plug into wall outlets.



## Connecting Satellite Speakers to Soundbar (Optional)

1. The satellite speakers can be used independently, or can be attached to the ends of the soundbar as described below.
2. Detach both caps from the ends of the soundbar.
3. Detach the bases from the bottoms of the two satellite speakers.
4. Screw the bottoms of the two satellites onto the two ends of the soundbar.
5. You are now ready to mount the soundbar to the wall. Please store the extra bases and caps in a safe location for use later.



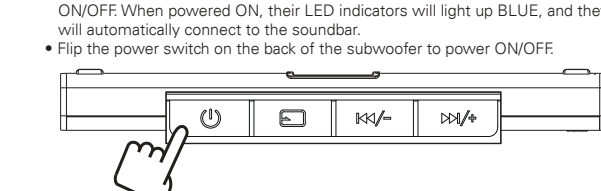
## Wall Mounting the Soundbar

1. Remove the soundbar and its contents from packaging.
2. Using a pencil, mark two spots on a wall measuring 32 inches apart.
3. If installing to a wooden surface, hammer a nail, or drive or drill a mounting screw (mounting materials not included) into the wall at each marked location. If installing to drywall or a brick surface, you may need to install plastic anchors to properly secure the mounting screws.
4. Place and hang the soundbar from its mounting holes on the back onto the installed mounting nails or screws.



## Powering ON/OFF

- Connect the soundbar to power.
- Press the power (D) button on the soundbar to power ON or OFF.
- Press the power (D) button on the remote control to enter/exit standby mode. See the **Remote Control** section for details.
- Press the power buttons on the backs of the satellite speakers to power them ON/OFF. When powered ON, their LED indicators will light up BLUE, and they will automatically connect to the soundbar.
- Flip the power switch on the back of the subwoofer to power ON/OFF.

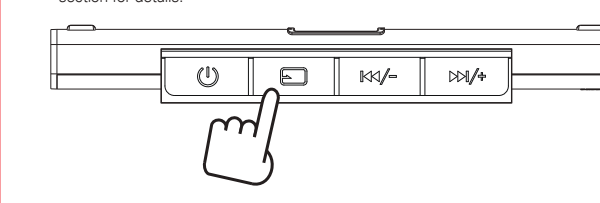


## Connecting the Sound System

1. Connect the soundbar and subwoofer to power. Charge the satellite speakers.
2. Power all units ON at the same time.
3. After a moment, they will automatically connect to each other.

## Changing Input Modes

- Press the (D) button on the soundbar to change input modes.
- You can also select a mode using the remote control. See the **Remote Control** section for details.



## Adjusting Volume & Playback

- **Press + hold** the **⏮** and **⏭** buttons on the speaker to adjust volume.
- Press the **⏮** and **⏭** buttons on the speaker to skip tracks.
- The remote control can also be used to adjust volume and playback. See the **Remote Control** section for instructions.
- In some modes, volume & playback can only be adjusted with the controls on your connected or paired device.
