



## Getting Started

## Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the supplied USB charging cable into the charging port on the front of the speaker. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into an electrical outlet.

The charging LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. When the speaker is low on power, a tone will be heard indicating that it needs to be recharged.

- Powering ON/OFF
   Turn the [MAIN VOL/ POWER] dial clockwise until it clicks to power ON. A voice will be heard, and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. It will automatically re-pair to any nearby, previously-paired device with Bluetooth enabled.
- Turn the [MAIN VOL/ POWER] dial counter-clockwise until it clicks to power OFF.

## MAIN VOL / POWER

### Adjusting Volume

In all modes, overall volume can be adjusted with the [MAIN VOL/ POWER] dial on the front of the speaker.

In AUX and Bluetooth modes, volume can also be controlled by your connected

### Changing Input Modes

Press the [M] button on the front of the speaker to switch input modes.

### Using the Lights

Press the [\*] button on the speaker to change light modes and power OFF.

- 1. Power the speaker ON. A voice will be heard and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The LED screen will **flash "bLUE**." Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When the list appears, select PBT9518 from the found devices.
- 3. After a successful pairing, a voice will be heard and the LED screen will **solidly** display "bLUE."
- In Bluetooth mode, playback and volume can be adjusted by the controls on the front of the speaker, or by the controls on your paired device.

  • Press the [Hi] button to pause and resume playback.
- Press the [I◀◀/ECHO -] and [►► /ECHO +] buttons to skip tracks.

## Using the 3.5 mm AUX Input

Insert one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (not included) into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input port on the front of the speaker. Insert the other connector into the headphone jack or 3.5 mm aux output port on your media-playing device.

Switch input modes until you reach AUX mode. The LED screen will display the

In AUX mode, all playback will be controlled by your connected device.

Note: For best power transfer, ensure cable is firmly connected to both devices.

Insert a TF card into the TF card input port on the speaker with the metal contacts facing down. Push in until it clicks.

Note: You must have a TF card inserted to switch to TF input mode.

Change input modes until you enter TF card mode. The speaker will automatically begin playing music off the device.

In TF card mode, control playback with the controls on the speaker.

• Press the [HI] button to pause and resume playback. • Press the [►► / ECHO +] and [I◄ / ECHO -] buttons to skip tracks.

## Using the FM Radio

Change input modes until you enter FM radio mode. The LED screen will display the current FM radio frequency.

In FM radio mode, playback will be controlled by the buttons on the front of the speaker. • Press the [>|| ] button to start or stop scanning and saving available radio stations.

- The LED screen will show the scanning progress. If it is not stopped, the radio will make a complete scan and save of all nearby radio stations.
- Press the [►►I/ ECHO +] and [I≪/ ECHO -] buttons to skip through saved stations.

### Using the USB Port

To charge or power a device, insert the USB connector of your device's USB cable (not included) into the USB Port on the speaker's control panel
