# Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the charging port on the back of the speaker. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer, or into a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall outlet.

The LED indicator will **turn RED** while charging and turn OFF when fully charged. When the speaker is low on power, a tone will be heard indicating that it ne be recharged.

## Powering ON/OFF

- Press and hold the [①] button to power ON and OFF.
  When powered ON, the speaker may automatically re-pair to a previously-paired
